A merit- and character-based award supporting the next generation of leaders — applied toward tuition, books, supplies, technology, or other qualified educational expenses.

Who Can Apply

- High school juniors and seniors, and current college or graduate students (ages 16–25)
- U.S. citizens, permanent residents, or DACA recipients
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Demonstrated involvement in school, community, or volunteer activities

What We Ask For

- 1 Your most recent school transcript (unofficial is fine)
- 2 A short bio about yourself, including a photo
- 3 An essay: “How will this scholarship help me be a light for others?” — tell us about the impact you’ll be making
- 4 One letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach, employer, or community leader
