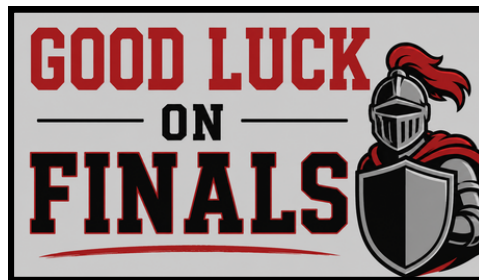


Students in Mrs. Lewis' Physics class launching the rockets they designed and built.
