



ARE YOU EXPERIENCING A HOUSING HARDSHIP?

IF YOU OR YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS AND ATTEND SBCSC:

- In a shelter
- In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation
- In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station
- Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship

You or your child may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

-
- ✓ Receive a free, appropriate public education.
 - ✓ Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
 - ✓ Enroll in the local school; or continue attending the school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference.
 - ✓ Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
 - ✓ Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students.
