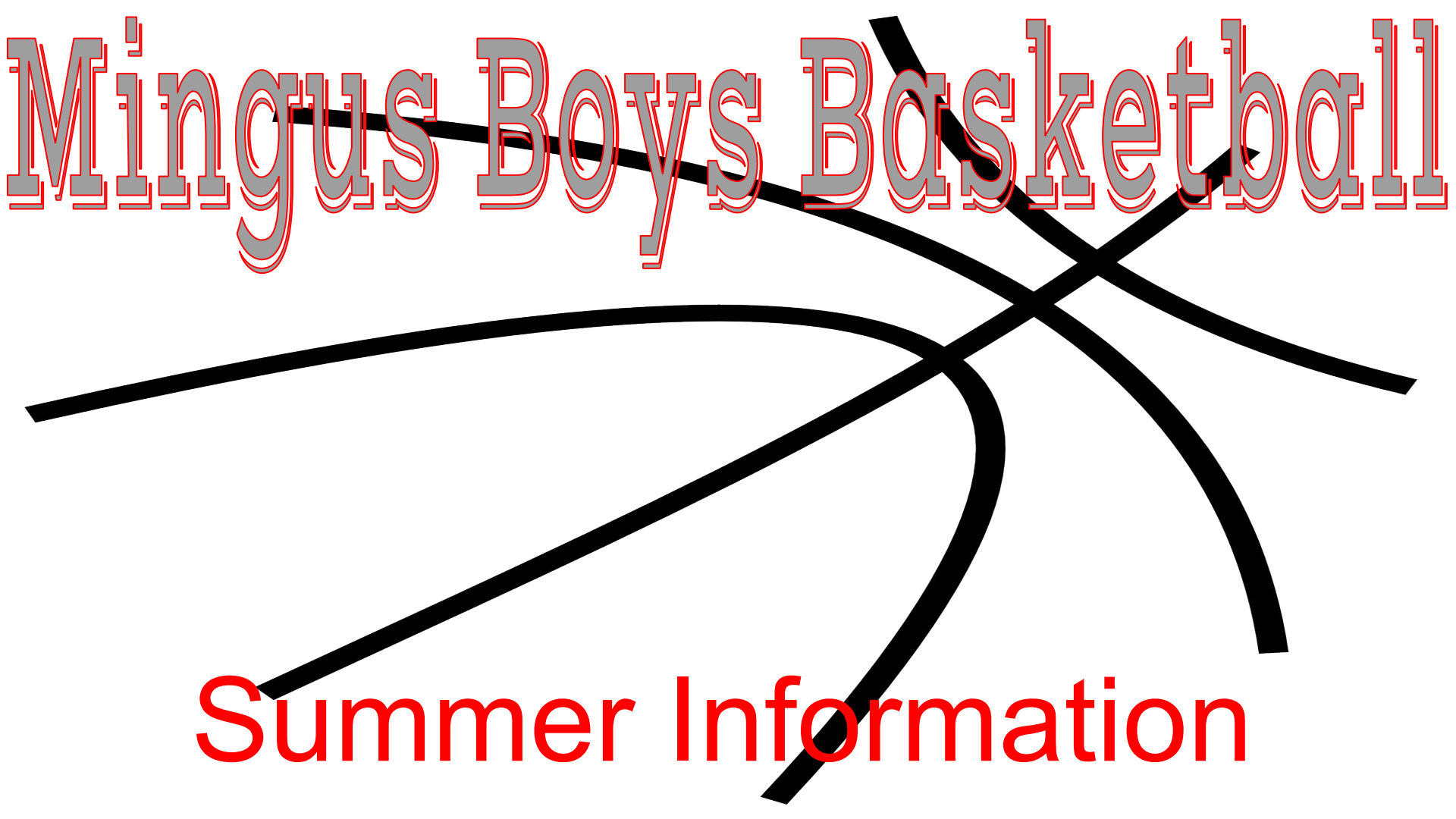

Participation Requirements

- 1. Any new players must have parent permission slips signed before participating in any off-season team activity.*
- 2. Only Mingus students can participate. Incoming Freshman are eligible to start once they are registered at Mingus and have graduated 8th grade*
- 3. All prospective players should get the Remind App and register with Coach Hudson to receive all team communications. Parents can also be added to our Remind group. This is the best way to ensure effective communication throughout the program.*

Summer Expectations

- 1) Always Be 10 minutes EARLY, ready to go, no phones in the gym - *if you show up late or are on your phone, you'll be asked to leave.*
- 2) **ALL PLAYERS** must ride the team bus to all summer games and tournaments. Players may ride home with their own parents if prior communication is given.
- 3) Full participation is expected in our summer basketball program - Don't choose vacations, summer work, or hanging out with friends over us. If you have a *legitimate conflict, you must communicate.* **Find a ride. Find a way. No excuses.**
- 4) All players are **required** to be present for Rec Center Kids Camp (**Dates June 22nd - 25th**)
- 5) Playing time is **NEVER** guaranteed. Your job is to play your best and cheer on your teammates when you are off the floor. **Earn everything!**
- 6) Players must represent themselves and our team with class and sportsmanship at all times. **Watch your language and how you conduct yourself** on and off the court!
- 7) All players must understand that there are only two reasons for Summer Basketball: 1) To get better 2) To grow as a team. **Be Coachable and be a Great Teammate!**
