

SUMMER at Lakeside

2026 REFUND AND WITHDRAWAL POLICY

All payments for summer programs are due by June 1, unless you are a Lakeside school-year family who has opted to be billed via Veracross.

Refunds: All questions about refunds should be directed to the Summer at Lakeside Office (SummerSchool@lakesideschool.org). **No refunds for any summer programs will be offered after June 1 for any reason.**

High School Course Withdrawal Fees

- \$50 fee for withdrawals that occur on or before April 1.
- \$100 fee for withdrawals that occur between April 2 and May 1.
- Fifty percent (50%) of the tuition between May 2 and June 1.
- No refunds will be made for withdrawals after June 1.

Investigative Learning Camp/Investigative Learning Camp Junior Withdrawal Fees

- \$50 fee for withdrawals that occur on or before April 1.
- \$100 fee for withdrawals that occur between April 2 and May 1.
- Fifty percent (50%) of the tuition between May 2 and June 1.
- No refunds will be made for withdrawals after June 1.

Athletics Camp Withdrawal Fees

- \$25 fee for withdrawals that occur on or before April 1.
- \$50 fee for withdrawals that occur between April 2 and May 1.
- Fifty percent (50%) of the tuition between May 2 and June 1.
- No refunds will be made for withdrawals after June 1.

Withdrawals from For-Credit Courses:

Students who withdraw from a course will not earn credit for the course or receive a grade. Refund and withdrawal policies listed above still apply. For Lakeside students, the discretionary Summer School course withdrawal period for a six-week course is the first two weeks of class. The withdrawal period for a three-week course is the first week of class. If a Lakeside student withdraws from the course before that time, the course will not appear on the student's transcript. If a Lakeside student withdraws from the course after that time, the notation on the student's transcript will be W (withdraw). Refund and withdrawal policies listed above still apply. All withdrawals must be requested in writing to the Summer at Lakeside Office at SummerSchool@lakesideschool.org.

Force Majeure Clause

Summer at Lakeside will not be responsible or legally liable for any tuition refund or for any loss, costs or damages for any delay or failure of its performance under this agreement, including any changes in programming, cancellation or other alteration, resulting from an act of God or other condition beyond its control (force majeure). Conditions resulting in a force majeure include but are not limited to fire or other natural disaster, war, violence or terrorism, infectious disease epidemic, or other disruptive major event. In the event of a force majeure, Summer at Lakeside will suspend or alter its performance if and until, in its sole discretion, it is able to appropriately resume performance.
