



SUN Bucks provides \$120 in grocery benefits per eligible school-age child when school is out for summer.

Children who get SUN Bucks can also participate in Summer Meals programs.

Your child may be eligible if your family's annual gross income* is **LESS THAN:**

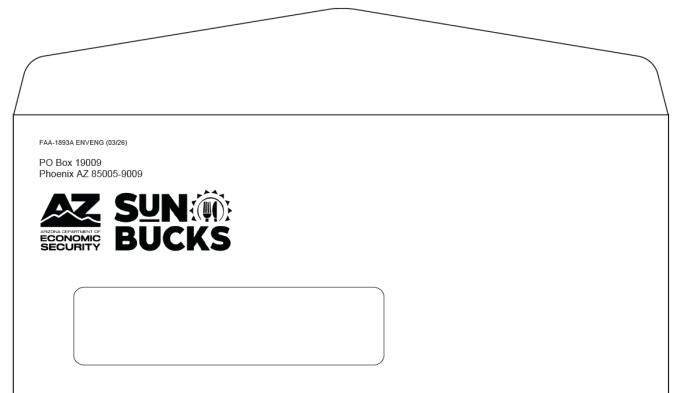
How does SUN Bucks work?

- Families that participate in SNAP or TANF will receive funds directly to their existing household's Arizona EBT card.
- If you have an Arizona EBT card from card from Summer 2024 or Summer 2025*, benefits will be loaded directly onto the EBT card. For questions, please contact the EBT card SUN Bucks hotline at 1 (833) 648-4406.
- If you do not have an Arizona EBT card, one will be mailed to you with your SUN Bucks benefits pre-loaded onto the card. The card works like a debit card.
- If you have more than one eligible child, you will only get one card per household. For example, if you have 2 eligible kids, you will get one card with \$240 total.
- SUN Bucks must be used within 122 days of the date when benefits are loaded onto the card.

*Benefits will be loaded onto Summer 2024 or Summer 2025 EBT cards in most cases.

Attention families:

- Do not discard the letter that comes with your card. It contains your case number, which will be needed to set up your card's PIN!
- Ensure that your child's school has your most current mailing address to avoid any delay.
- Don't leave your benefits on the shelf! Unused benefits will be removed on day 123.



The SUN Bucks application will close on August 3, 2026.

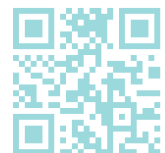
