

BDBB - RETAINING AN ATTORNEY

When the District determines legal counsel is necessary, it may employ an attorney licensed to practice law in the state of North Dakota. A decision to seek legal advice or assistance on behalf of the District shall be made by the Superintendent, Board President, or designee. The Board may also formally direct the Superintendent to seek legal counsel. The decision on whether to retain counsel shall be consistent with approved district policy or standard practice. However, if the Superintendent concludes that unusual types or amounts of professional legal service may be required, the Superintendent shall seek board authorization prior to obtaining those legal services.
