Additional Compensation Opportunities

Leadership Compensation:
Faculty in positions of leadership that coordinate others and/or support the operational or curricular needs of the school are eligible to receive an additional annual salary adjustment.

Stipends:
Faculty dedicating time as an advisor for teams, clubs, or groups that require practice, competition, summer duties, performance, or publication are eligible for additional stipends.

Other Unique Benefits:

- Reimbursing teacher licensure testing and application fees with faculty commitments.
- Up to \$2,500 in tuition reimbursement annually.
