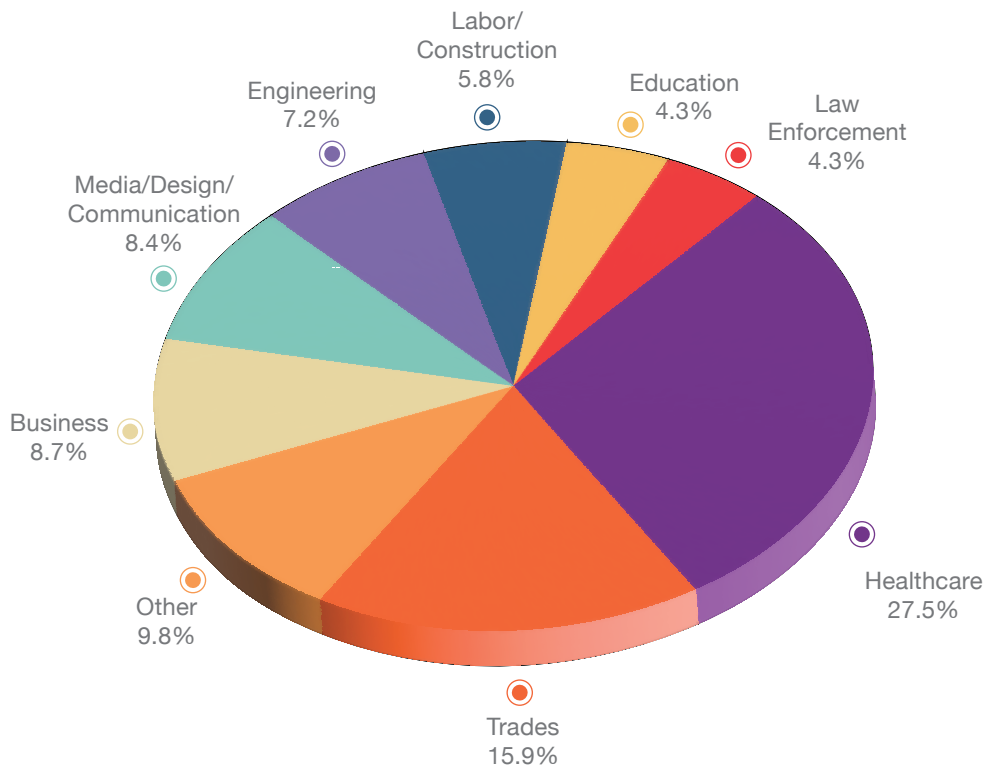


Over 78% of our students participated in extra-curricular opportunities.

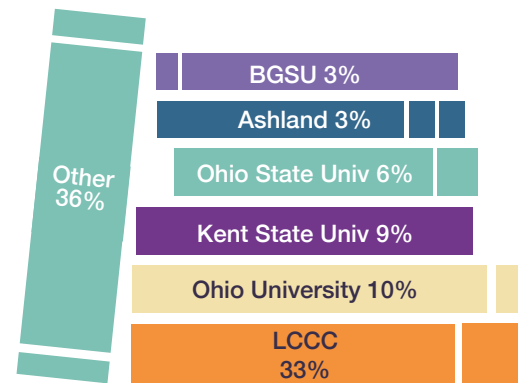


Over 68% of our students participated in athletics.
