7. Do not submit the form if you are not going to be able to commit to National Honor Society and the service project requirements. This is a service organization. If you are too busy to participate, you should not submit an application.

Explanation of Character and Student Essay

A person of character demonstrates the following six qualities: *respect, responsibility, trustworthiness, fairness, caring, and citizenship*. The Faculty Council, which elects new National Honor Society members, looks at the following characteristics of a student:

- Takes criticism willingly and accepts recommendations graciously
- Consistently exemplifies desirable qualities of behavior (i.e. cheerfulness, friendliness, poise, stability)
- Upholds principles of morality and ethics
- Complies with school regulations concerning property, programs, office, etc.
- Demonstrates the highest standards of honesty and reliability
- Regularly shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others
- Observes instructions and rules, is punctual and faithful both inside and outside of the classroom
- Has powers of concentration, self-discipline, and sustained attention as shown by perseverance and application to studies
- Manifests truthfulness in acknowledging obedience to rules, avoiding cheating in written work, and showing willingness not to profit by mistakes of either self or others.
- Actively helps the school to eliminate the negative influences to the environment.
- DO NOT RESTATE YOUR ACTIVITY SHEETS! Make connections.

Now that you have read and reflected on the attributes of a National Honor Society Member, explain why you feel you qualify for membership in the National Honor Society. Use statements which stress the *character, service and leadership* qualities described in the above sections. Please TYPE your essay and submit it with the other forms in your application. All essays must be 300 words or less and DOUBLE SPACED with paragraphs.
