

RISK MANAGEMENT

It shall be the policy of the Yellowstone School Board to take positive actions to reduce the potential liability of the District whenever possible. This will include adequate insurance coverage in compliance with applicable insurance requirements under law, a pro-active safety program, and close supervision of any unemployment compensation and workers' compensation claims.

The safety program will include adequate maintenance and repair of facilities, including playgrounds, and the installation and supervision of playground equipment that is recognized as safe. It will also include accident reports and first-aid and supervision policies that seek to reduce the potential for injury to students, staff, and public.
