**Approval to Decline Participation
In Schools of Choice**

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The option to offer Schools of Choice is part of the current School Aid Act under Section 105. Under the Schools of Choice option the State permits school districts to accept for enrollment students who reside out of the district boundary but within in the Wayne RESA (Intermediate School District).

The Board of Education of the Grosse Pointe Public School System has never elected to participate as a Schools of Choice district.

The Board of Education is requesting to affirm their desire to decline participation in School of Choice as well as their desire for the district to remain closed to that option for the 2026-2027 school year.

It is the intent of the Board of Education to vote on this prior to the start of school.

That the Grosse Pointe Board of Education approve the attached resolution declining to participate in Schools of Choice for the 2026-2027 school year.

WHEREAS, the Michigan Legislature, under the 1996-97 School Aid Act, MCL 388.1705, permits school districts to accept for enrollment non-resident students residing within the same intermediate school district (ISD), and

WHEREAS, the Grosse Pointe Public School District has determined not to implement Schools of Choice for the 2026-2027 school year and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Grosse Pointe Public School System is cognizant of its present and longstanding written policy, article IV, section 4.02 (Enrollment: Non-Resident Students) which permits the enrollment of a non-resident student whose family has purchased a home within the district but has not yet relocated by the start of the semester, as well as a high school senior whose family is moving out of the district and who wants to complete his/her senior year in the district, and the Board of Education's desire to continue to implement this previously existing policy because it is in the best interest of children and young adults; and

WHEREAS, the Grosse Pointe Public School Board of Education has determined to vote on this option prior to the start of school.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Grosse Pointe Public School District will not, under the Schools of Choice option, accept applications from non-resident students residing within the intermediate district for the 2026-2027 school year.
