NRH - 8th GRADE 2026-2027 Resources

Uniform Requirement

(BLAZERS MUST BE WORN ON FORMAL MONDAY'S STARTING MONDAY AUGUST 26th, 2024!)

Monday: Khaki Pants with a black belt, Knee Length Plaid Skirt (girls only), White Button Down Shirt With Logo, Plaid Tie or Neck Tab for girls, Solid Black Dress Shoes And Black Crew Socks (boys), solid black or solid white closed-toe dress shoes or penny loafers (girls) with solid white knee length socks or tights.

Tuesday-Friday: Khaki Pants or Shorts, Knee Length Khaki Skirt/Skort (girls only), ILTexas Polo, Black Belt, Solid Black Tennis Shoes And Black Crew Socks (boys), solid white or solid black tennis shoes and white crew or knee high socks or white footed tights (girls).

Physical Fitness/Athletics Uniform: All students in grades 6-8 are required to wear the ILTexas approved physical fitness uniform from Academic Outfitters.

Makeup: Girls in grades 6-8 may wear moderate natural makeup, which may include foundation, blush and mascara. Makeup may not be applied during instructional time.

Jewelry: Girls' jewelry must not pose a distraction. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings. Body piercings are not acceptable. If a student has a nose piercing, the nose ring must be removed or a filler – instead of the jewelry- must be worn during school hours.

No Hoodies: No Hoodies including Pullover or Zip up even if purchased at an approved ILTexas vendor will be allowed.

Política uniforme requirement (ESPANOL)

(¡LOS BLAZERS DEBEN USARSE EL LUNES FORMAL A PARTIR DEL LUNES 26 DE AGOSTO DE 2024!)

Lunes: pantalones caqui o pantalones grises con cinturón negro, falda a cuadros hasta la rodilla (solo niñas), camisa blanca con botones y logo, corbata a cuadros o pestaña en el cuello para niñas, zapatos de vestir negros sólidos y calcetines negros (niños), lisos Zapatos de vestir cerrados, negros o blancos sólidos, o mocasines (niñas) con medias o medias blancas sólidas hasta la rodilla.

De martes a viernes: pantalones o pantalones cortos de color caqui, falda/pantalón color caqui hasta la rodilla (solo niñas), polo ILTexas, cinturón negro, zapatos tenis negros sólidos y calcetines negros (niños), zapatos tenis blancos o negros sólidos y calcetines o rodilla blancos. calcetines altos o medias blancas (niñas).

Uniforme de aptitud física/atletismo
