NRH Kindergarten

Uniform Requirement

Monday:

Boys - Khaki Pants, Black Belt, White Button Down Shirt With Logo, ILTexas Plaid Tie, Solid Black Tennis Shoes and Black Crew Socks

Girls - Plaid Jumper Dress worn with Maroon or Black Modesty Shorts, White Peter Pan Blouse, Solid White Tennis Shoes, White Knee High Socks or Solid White Footed Tights.

Tuesday-Friday

Boys: Khaki Pants or Shorts, ILTexas Polo, Black Belt, Solid Black Tennis Shoes and Black Crew Socks.

Girls – Khaki Pants, Khaki Shorts or Khaki Skort – must be uniform design and knee length, ILTexas Polo Shirt, or Khaki Jumper Dress with Logo, worn with Modesty Shorts, Solid White Tennis Shoes and White Crew or Knee High Socks or White Footed Tights.

Lunes:

Niños – Pantalón color caqui, cinturón negro, camisa blanca de botones con logotipo, corbata a cuadros de ILTexas, tenis completamente negros y calcetines negros tipo crew (largos).

Niñas – Jumper (vestido) a cuadros, usado con shorts de modestia color vino (maroon) o negro, blusa blanca estilo Peter Pan, tenis completamente blancos, calcetas blancas largas hasta la rodilla o medias blancas completas.

Martes a Viernes:

Niños – Pantalón o shorts color caqui, playera tipo polo de ILTexas, cinturón negro, tenis completamente negros y calcetines negros tipo crew (largos).

Martes a Viernes:

Niñas – Pantalón caqui, shorts caqui o falda pantalón (skort) color caqui (debe ser diseño oficial del uniforme y a la altura de la rodilla), playera tipo polo de ILTexas o jumper caqui con logotipo, usado con shorts de modestia, tenis completamente blancos y calcetas blancas tipo crew o largas hasta la rodilla, o medias blancas completas.
