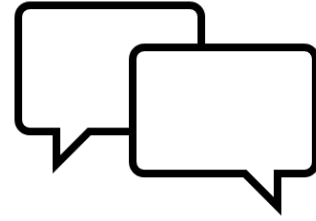
Trustworthiness means

Adam found a phone on the playground. He showed integrity (did the right thing) when he turned the phone into the lost and found at school.

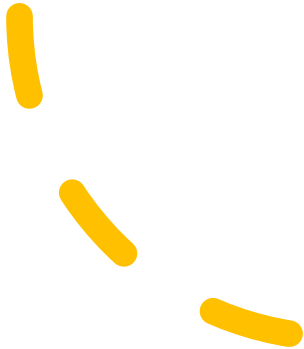

Examples:

Ariel wanted to be responsible, so she made sure to put her homework in her backpack right after she completed her work, this way she would have it for class the next day.

Max accidentally threw a ball into a window that broke the glass. He took responsibility for breaking the window when he told his dad what he had done and asked how to fix the situation.

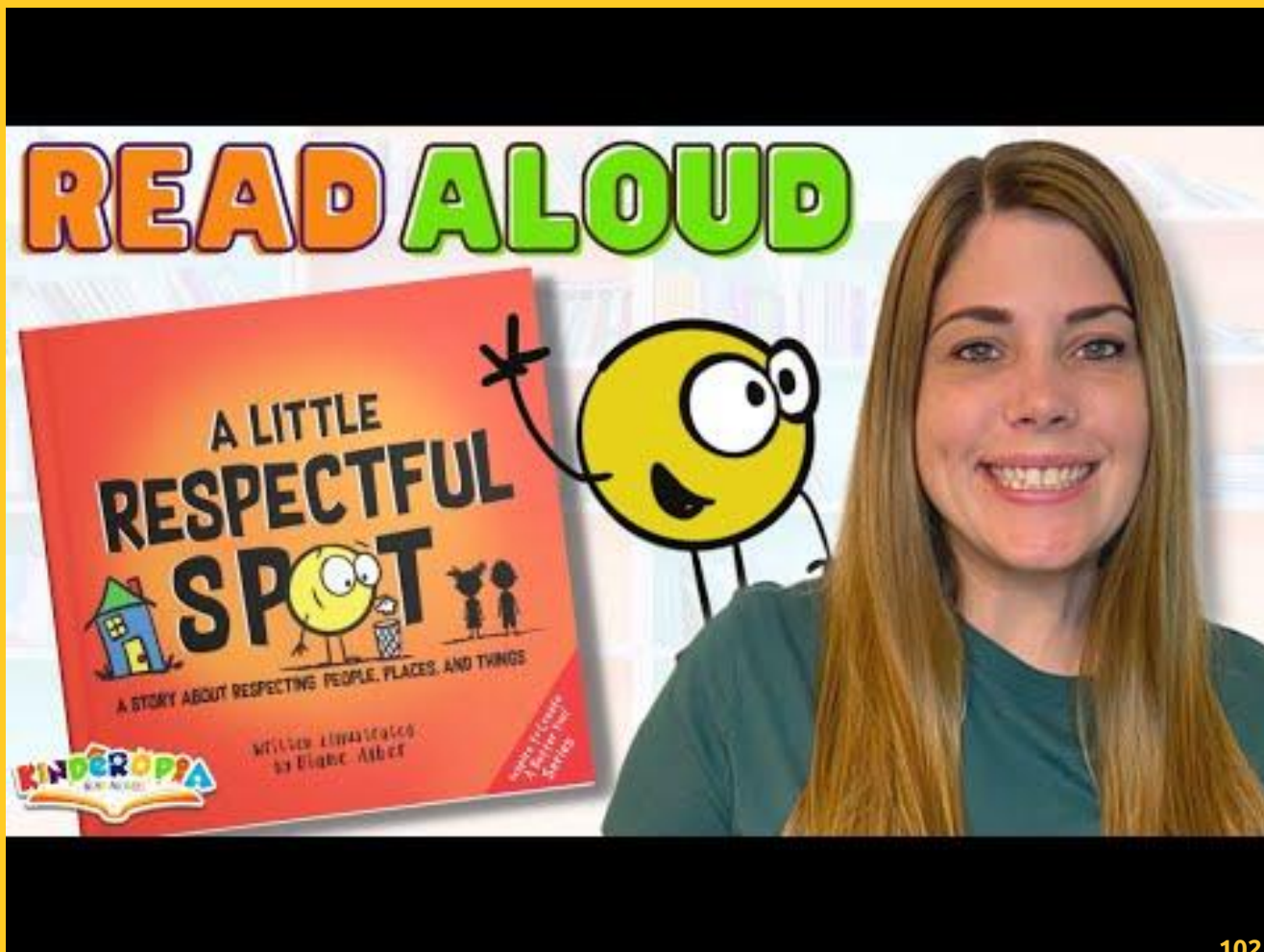

Example:

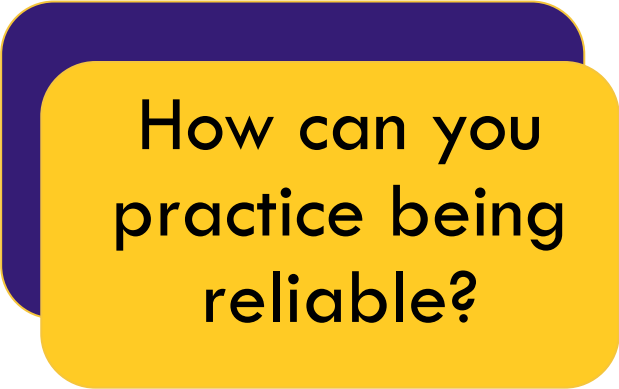

Examples of Common Good

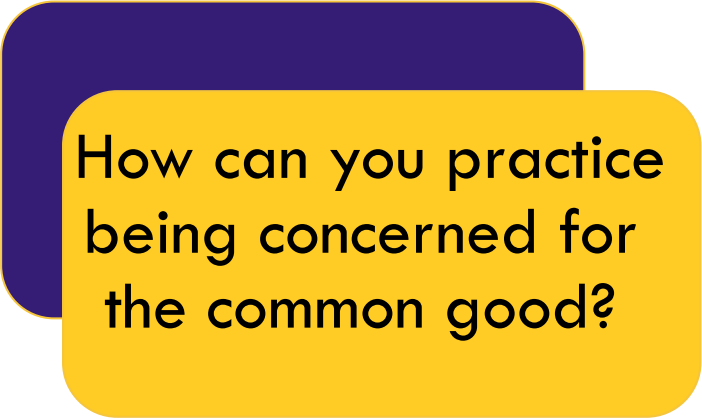
Having clean drinking water is a benefit for the common good for all community members
