 - Board approval for updated attendance boundaries



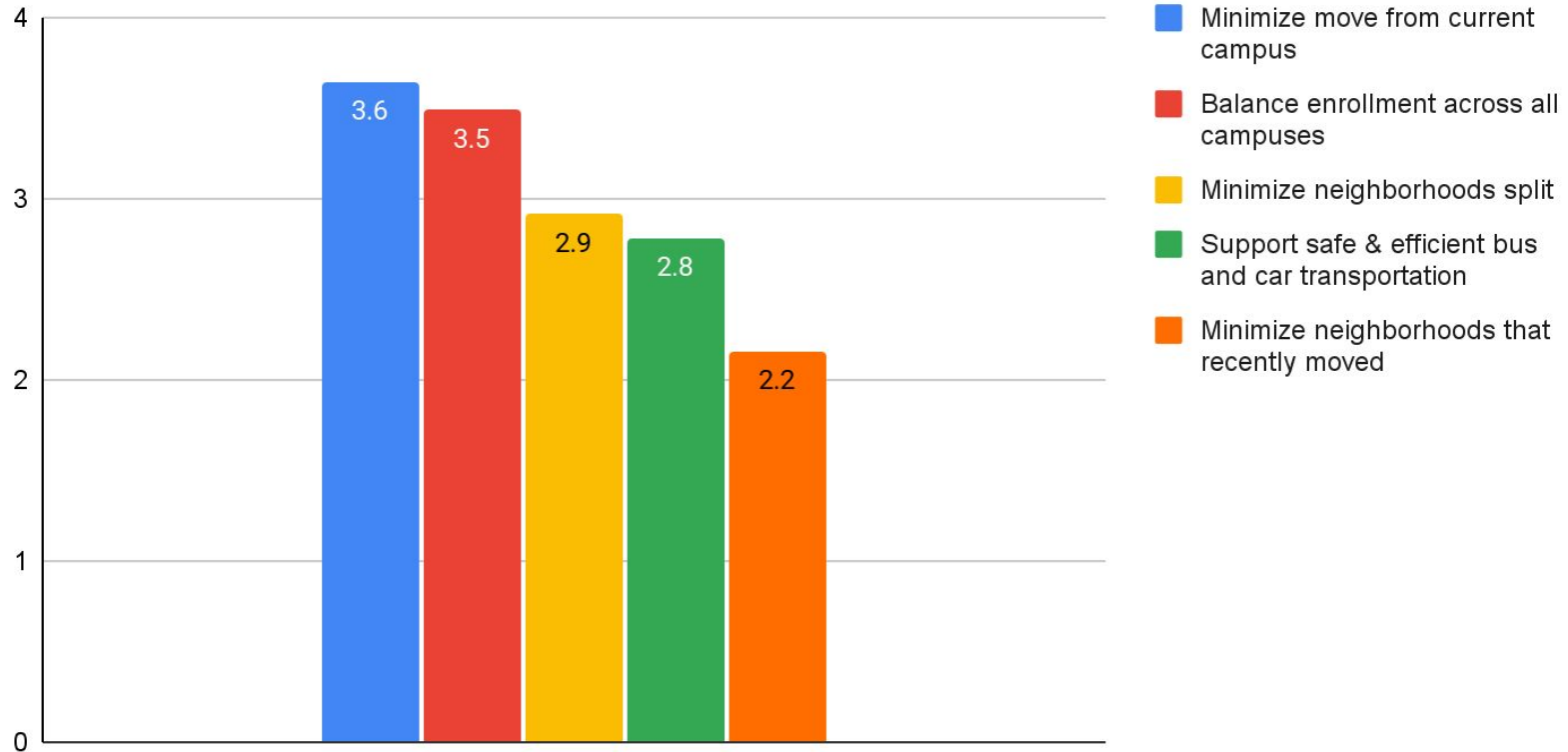

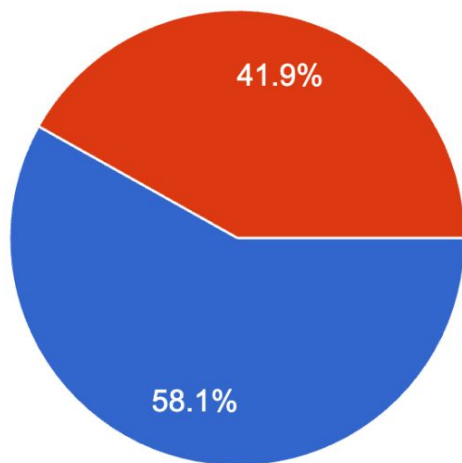

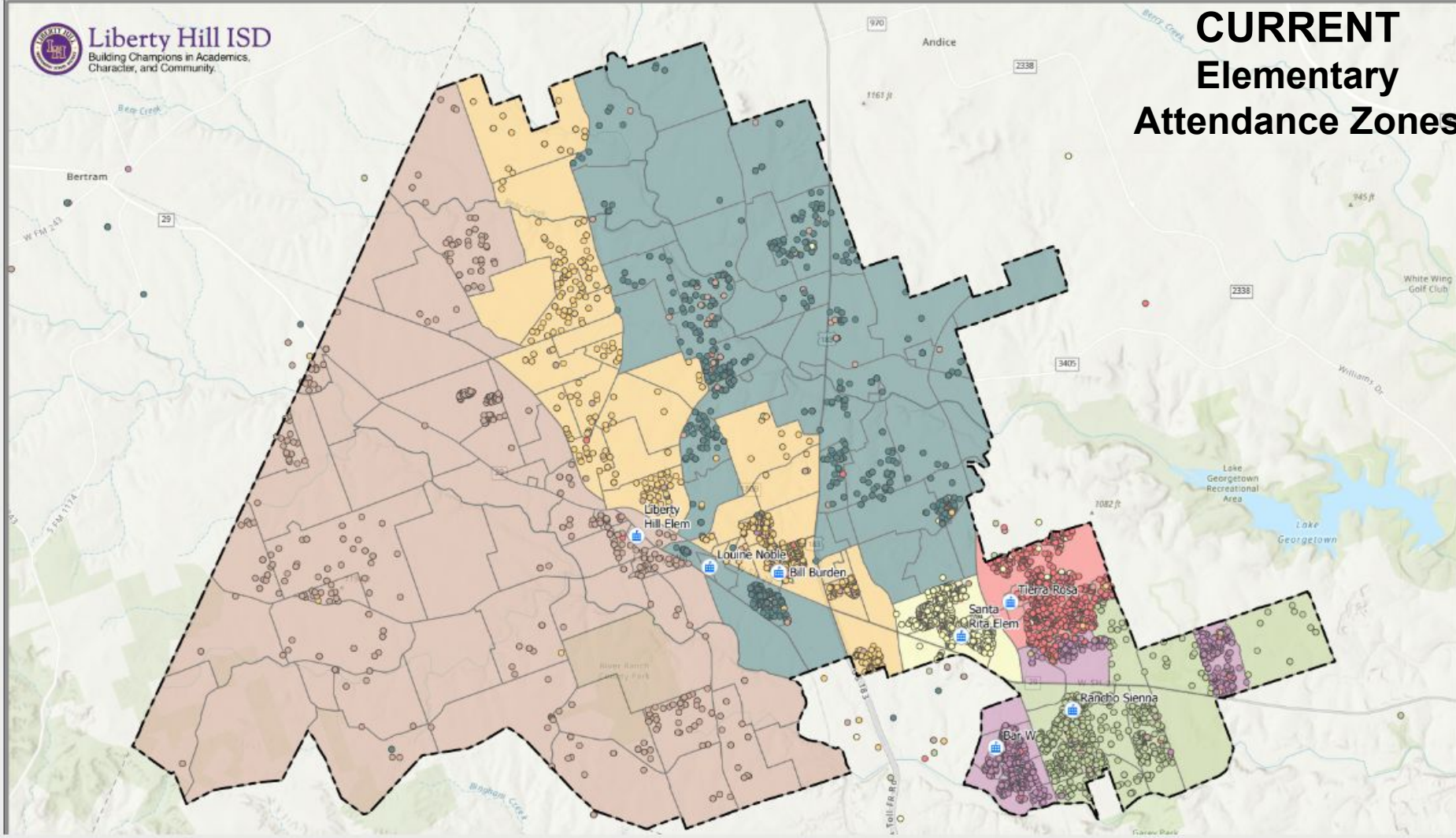
