 - After reading or listening to a story, retell the story to someone. You could imagine you're one of the characters and act it out.

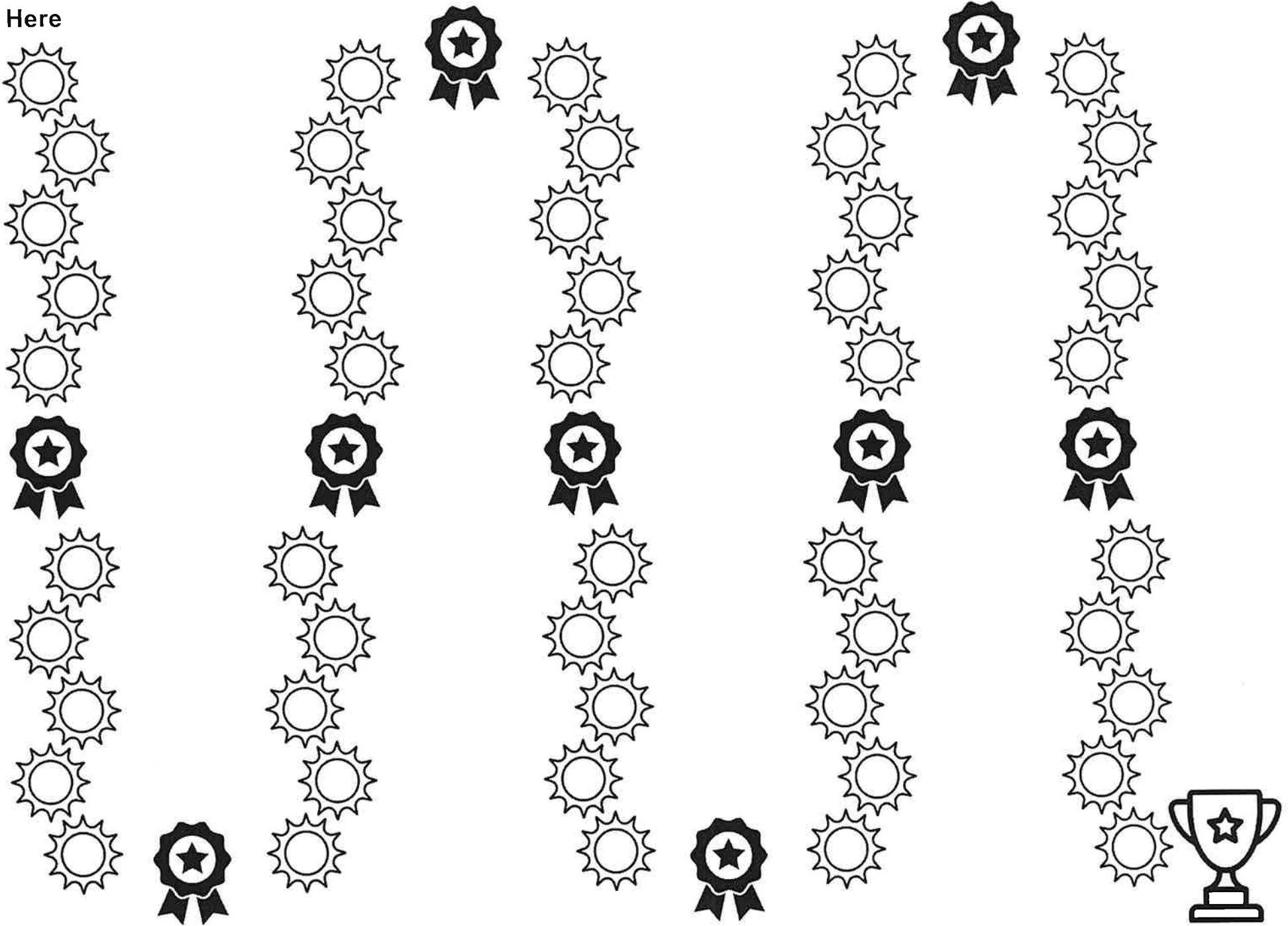
