Live Jesus!

In honor of the 250th anniversary of the birth of our nation, the U.S. Bishops have called for the consecration of the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Here at our parish, that invitation carries special meaning. Our chapel bears the name “The Chapel of the Sacred Heart,” and each First Friday, we Oblates of St. Francis de Sales renew our personal consecration to the Sacred Heart and invite our parishioners to join us in that act of trust and love.

Our devotion to the Sacred Heart is deeply connected to the spirituality of St. Francis de Sales and St. Jane de Chantal, founders of the Order of the Visitation. It was to a Visitation nun, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, that Jesus revealed his Sacred Heart in a series of apparitions beginning on December 27, 1673 — the feast of St. John the Apostle, the disciple who rested his head upon the breast of Christ at the Last Supper.

That date was providential. At that time, much of the Church was struggling under the influence of Jansenism, a harsh spirituality that emphasized fear, punishment, and human unworthiness. Many people had come to think of God as distant and severe rather than as merciful and loving. Into that spiritual climate came the revelation of the Sacred Heart: a reminder that the heart of God is filled with love, mercy, and compassion, not coldness.

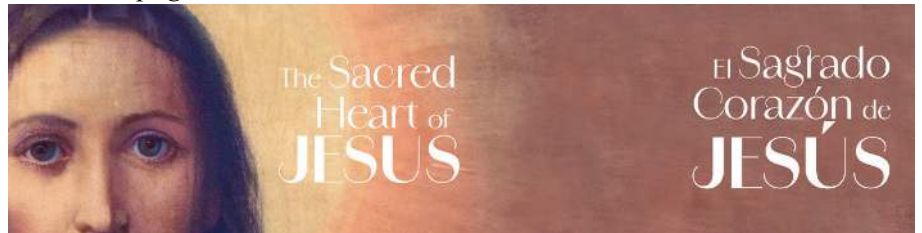
Jesus revealed his pierced Heart to St. Margaret Mary as a sign of his tender love for humanity. He came not to frighten souls into submission, but to draw them to himself through mercy, gentleness, and love. His words echo the Gospel invitation: “Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest... for I am gentle and humble of heart” (Mt 11:29).

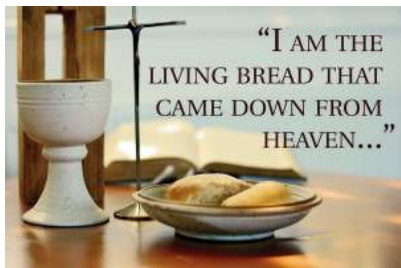

This same spirit is found throughout the writings of St. Francis de Sales. He urged people never to approach God with fear or discouragement, but with confidence in divine love and providence. He once wrote: "Do not be afraid... let your weary heart rest against the sacred, loving breast of this Savior." In Salesian spirituality, the Sacred Heart is not merely a symbol of devotion; it is the revelation of who God truly is — patient, merciful, approachable, and faithful.

In his final apparition to St. Margaret Mary, Jesus asked that a feast honoring his Sacred Heart be celebrated on the Friday after the Feast of Corpus Christi. That connection is deeply meaningful. Corpus Christi celebrates Christ remaining with his people in the Eucharist. The feast of the Sacred Heart reveals the love that moved him to remain with us. Jesus desires to dwell among his people, to walk with them, to nourish them, and to draw close to every human heart.

It was on Good Friday that his Heart was pierced by the soldier's lance, and from that open Heart flowed blood and water — signs of the Eucharist and Baptism, signs of the Church born from the redeeming love of Christ.

Thus, the feast of the Sacred Heart is ultimately the feast of Jesus as Emmanuel — God with us as our Savior, Lord, and loving Friend.

As our nation marks the 250th anniversary of its founding, may this consecration to the Sacred Heart renew in all of us a deeper trust in the love and mercy of Christ. And may His Sacred Heart watch over and guide our nation in the countless years that lie ahead.

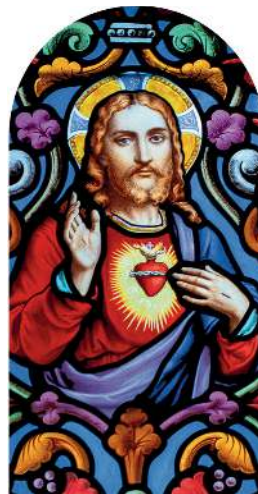

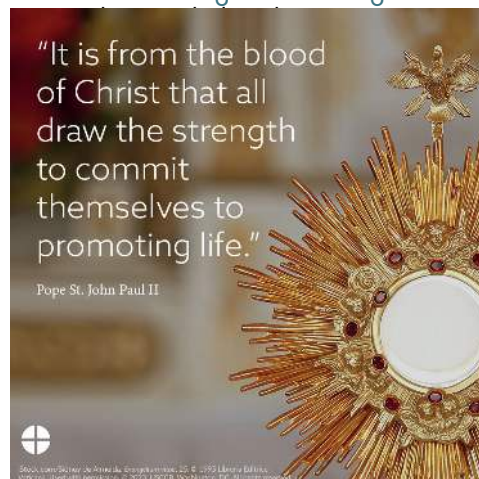

¡Vive Jesús!

En honor al ducentésimo quincuagésimo (250th) aniversario del nacimiento de nuestra nación, los obispos de los Estados Unidos han convocado a la consagración de los Estados Unidos al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús.

Aquí, en nuestra parroquia, esa invitación cobra un significado especial. Nuestra capilla lleva el nombre de «Capilla del Sagrado Corazón», y cada primer viernes, nosotros, los Oblatos de San Francisco de Sales, renovamos nuestra consagración personal al Sagrado Corazón e invitamos a nuestros feligreses a unirse a nosotros en ese acto de confianza y amor.

Nuestra devoción al Sagrado Corazón está profundamente vinculada a la espiritualidad de San Francisco de Sales y Santa Juana de Chantal, fundadores de la Orden de la Visitación. Fue a una religiosa de la Visitación—Santa Margarita María de Alacoque—a quien Jesús reveló su Sagrado Corazón en una serie de apariciones que comenzaron el 27 de diciembre de 1673: la fiesta de San Juan Apóstol, el discípulo que reclinó su cabeza sobre el pecho de Cristo en la Última Cena.

Esa fecha fue providencial. En aquel tiempo, gran parte de la Iglesia se debatía bajo la influencia del jansenismo, una espiritualidad austera que ponía el énfasis en el miedo, el castigo y la indignidad humana. Muchas personas habían llegado a concebir a Dios como alguien distante y severo, en lugar de misericordioso y amoroso. En medio de ese clima espiritual, irrumpió la revelación del Sagrado Corazón: un recordatorio de que el corazón de Dios está colmado de amor, misericordia y compasión, no de frialdad.

Jesús reveló su Corazón traspasado a Santa Margarita María como signo de su tierno amor por la humanidad. Él no vino para someter a las almas mediante el miedo, sino para atraerlas hacia sí mediante la misericordia, la mansedumbre y el amor. Sus palabras hacen eco de la invitación evangélica: «Vengan a mí todos los que están fatigados y agobiados, y yo les daré descanso... pues soy manso y humilde de corazón» (Mt 11:29).

Este mismo espíritu se halla presente a lo largo de los escritos de San Francisco de Sales. Él exhortaba a las personas a no acercarse jamás a Dios con miedo o desánimo, sino con confianza en el amor y la providencia divinos. En una ocasión escribió: «No teman... dejen que su corazón fatigado descansa sobre el sagrado y amoroso pecho de este Salvador». En la espiritualidad salesiana, el Sagrado Corazón no es meramente un símbolo de devoción; es la revelación de quién es verdaderamente Dios: paciente, misericordioso, cercano y fiel.

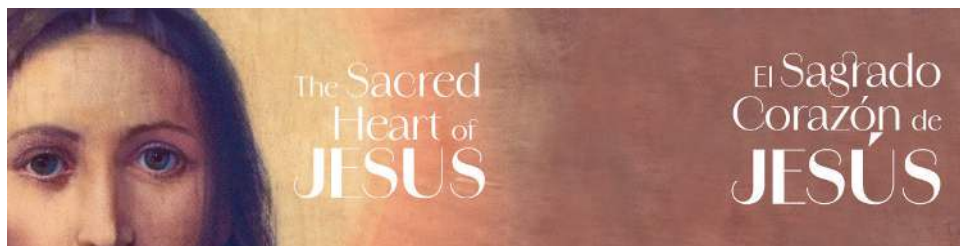
En su última aparición a Santa Margarita María, Jesús pidió que se celebrara una fiesta en honor a su Sagrado Corazón el viernes siguiente a la fiesta del Corpus Christi. Esta conexión es profundamente significativa. El Corpus Christi celebra la permanencia de Cristo junto a su pueblo en la Eucaristía. La fiesta del Sagrado Corazón revela el amor que lo impulsó a permanecer con nosotros. Jesús desea habitar entre su pueblo, caminar con él, nutrirlo y acercarse a cada corazón humano.

Fue el Viernes Santo cuando su Corazón fue traspasado por la lanza del soldado y de ese Corazón abierto brotaron sangre y agua: signos de la Eucaristía y del Bautismo, signos de la Iglesia nacida del amor redentor de Cristo.

Así pues, la fiesta del Sagrado Corazón es, en última instancia, la fiesta de Jesús como Emmanuel: Dios con nosotros, nuestro Salvador, Señor y Amigo amoroso.

Mientras nuestra nación conmemora el ducentésimo quincuagésimo (250.º) aniversario de su fundación, rogamos que esta consagración al Sagrado Corazón renueve en todos nosotros una confianza más profunda en el amor y la misericordia de Cristo. Y que su Sagrado Corazón vele por nuestra nación y la guíe en los incontables años que tiene por delante.
