



Getting Started with Christian Service Hours at Bishop Verot

Before committing to community service hours, please note the following:

Students must use their Bishop Verot email address when logging into MobileServe. To request a password and receive your student credentials from the Bishop Verot Technology Department, please follow the link below:

Once the student has a Bishop Verot email address...

1. On the student's personal device, download the Gmail app from the App Store.
2. Open the app and tap "+ Add Account."
3. Select "Google" and enter the student's BVHS email address and password
4. Please note: passwords are case-sensitive and CANNOT BE CHANGED.
5. Follow the link below and start using Mobileserve.

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Bishop Verot Christian Service Hour Basics

Pre-Approved Service Sites

Students may earn Christian Service Hours only at sites that are already listed and approved by Bishop Verot in the MobileServe app, on the school website, or in the school handbook. This ensures that service activities align with the mission and values of the program.

- A site or event that was approved in previous years will not be approved if it is not currently on the approved list.
- If your child wishes to work with organizations other than those listed, we certainly encourage them to do so as part of their personal growth. However, those hours will not count toward the minimum number of hours required each year.

Limit on School-Related Service Hours

- Students may earn a maximum of 10 total hours per year for school-related service activities.
- Summer camps operating under an LLC or serving as fundraising opportunities for a team will not count toward the service hour requirement. Please note that coaches may require participation in these camps, as they often serve as fundraising opportunities for a team or club.
- Approved school-related activities include Freshman Retreat and assisting in a special capacity as requested or authorized by an administrator.

Fundraising Activities

- Service hours will not be approved for any activity that involves fundraising for a team, club, or organization of which the student is a member. While these efforts are valuable, they are not considered Christian service because they directly offset expenses for the student or the student's family.

Verification Process

- Students must follow the approval and verification process using the MobileServe app (available on student phones). This includes three of the following four verification methods:
- Taking a photo at the service site. The **student's face must be visible** in the photo for the hours to count.
- Obtaining email approval from the supervisor listed in the app.
- Having a supervisor sign in the app at the time the service is completed.
- Utilizing the geolocation feature in the MobileServe app (if available).
