Summer 2026 Principals' Reading Challenge

Blodgett, Clemens, and Philomath Elementary Schools

As your principals, we believe there is no greater skill than learning to read and enjoy great books! Summertime is a great time to read and get lost in a story. We challenge our students entering grades 1-5 to read 20 minutes a day for **50** of the **79** days of June, July, and August (**June 12th-August 30th**).

Simply color in the days on the calendar that you read for at least 20 minutes, have your parent sign your calendar and turn it in to your school during the month of September 2026. If you get busy and miss some days, you can read

a lot in one day and count it on another day. For example, if you read 60 minutes in one day, you can count the extra minutes on days you missed.

What counts as summer reading? You read, you listen to someone read to you. Read a book, a comic book, a novel, a graphic novel, a picture book, or any kind of book!

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As the school year comes to a close, Benton County Health Department would like to share some important information to help your child be ready for school next fall.

[Get Ready for the Next School Year](#)

Summer is a great time to check your child's vaccine status and avoid delays when school starts. We encourage you to:

- Check which [vaccines are required for school and childcare](#).
- Review your child's vaccine records.
- Schedule any needed vaccine appointments.
- Ask questions about school vaccine requirements and other recommended vaccines.

If your child needs vaccines, contact their doctor or call the Health Department at 541-766-6835. Our Public Health Immunization Clinic is open Monday – Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Walk-ins are welcome.

[Why This Matters](#)

The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) recently reported that more students than ever are attending school without some or all required vaccines. Benton County schools are seeing a similar trend.

When fewer students are vaccinated, the risk of outbreaks of diseases like [measles](#) and [pertussis \(whooping cough\)](#) increases. These diseases spread quickly in schools and childcare programs.

[School Exclusion During an Outbreak](#)

Under Oregon law, students who are not fully vaccinated may be excluded from school or childcare during an outbreak. This helps protect them and prevent the disease from spreading.

Exclusions can last from several days to several weeks, depending on the disease. For example, during a measles outbreak, students who are not vaccinated must stay home for at least 21 days. Missing school can disrupt learning, activities, and family schedules.

Thank you for helping keep your child, school, and community healthy. We encourage you to check your child's vaccination status now so they are ready for a successful start to next school year.

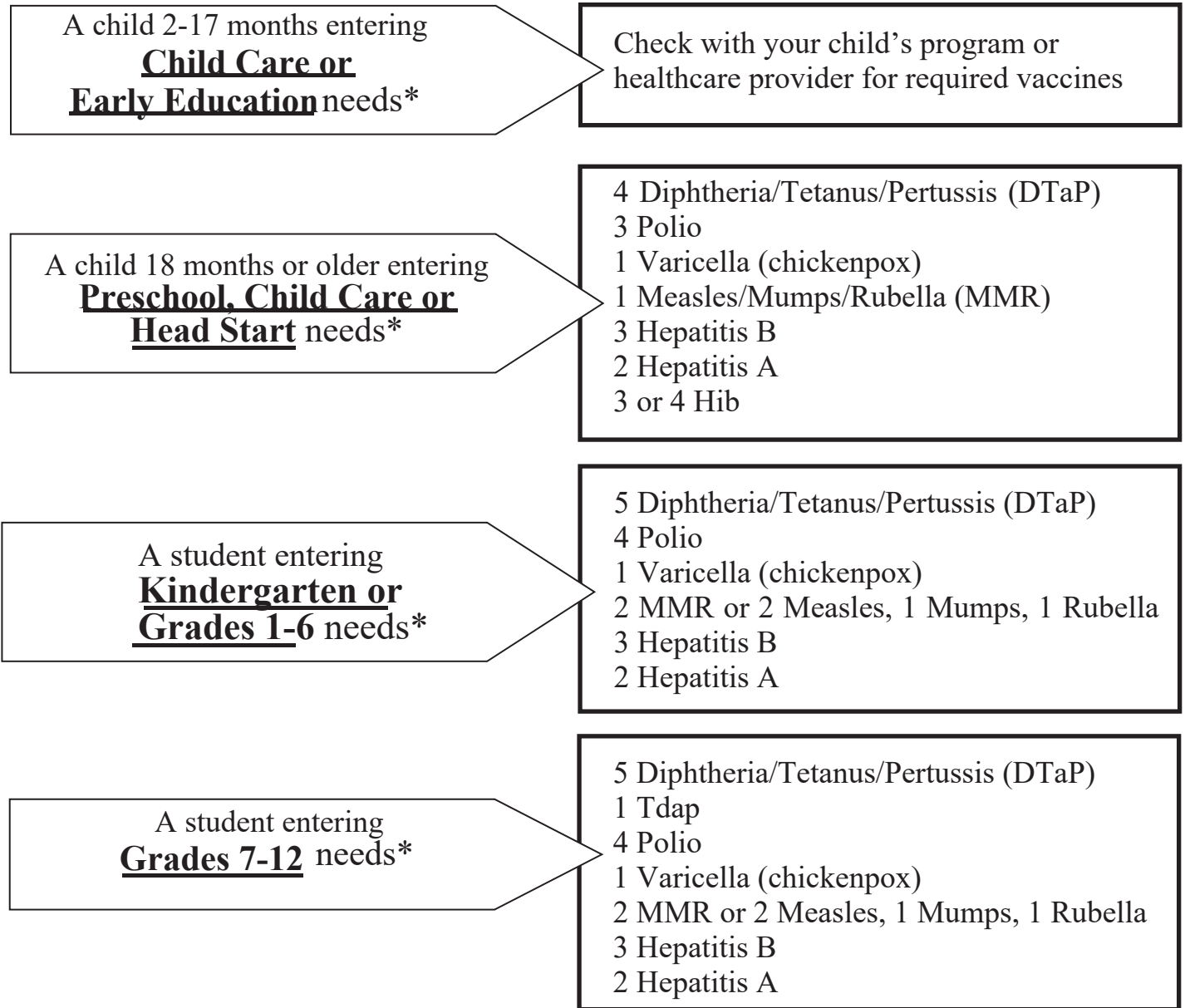

**At all ages and grades, the number of doses required varies by a child's age and how long ago they were vaccinated. Other vaccines may be recommended. Exemptions are also available. Please check with your child's school, child care or healthcare provider for details.*

El verano es un momento ideal para verificar el estado de vacunación de su hijo y evitar retrasos al comienzo del año escolar. Le recomendamos:

- Verificar qué [vacunas son obligatorias para la escuela y los centros de guarderías](#)
- Revisar el registro de vacunación de su hijo.
- Programar las citas de vacunación que sean necesarias.
- Hacer preguntas sobre los requisitos de vacunación escolar y otras vacunas recomendadas.

[Por qué esto es importante](#)

La Autoridad de Salud de Oregón (OHA por sus siglas en inglés) informó recientemente que, más que nunca, hay estudiantes que asisten a la escuela sin contar con algunas o todas las vacunas requeridas. Las escuelas del Condado de Benton están observando una tendencia similar.

Cuando hay menos estudiantes vacunados, aumenta el riesgo de brotes de enfermedades como el [sarampión](#) y la [tos ferina](#). Estas enfermedades se propagan rápidamente en las escuelas y en los centros de guarderías.

[Exclusión escolar durante un brote](#)

Según la ley de Oregón, los estudiantes que no están completamente vacunados pueden ser excluidos de la escuela o del centro de cuidado infantil durante un brote. Esto ayuda a protegerlos y a prevenir la propagación de la enfermedad.

Las exclusiones pueden durar desde varios días hasta varias semanas, dependiendo de la enfermedad. Por ejemplo, durante un brote de sarampión, los estudiantes que no están vacunados deben permanecer en casa durante al menos 21 días. Faltar a la escuela puede interrumpir el aprendizaje, las actividades y los horarios familiares.

Gracias por ayudar a mantener saludables a sus hijos, a la escuela y a la comunidad. Le recomendamos verificar ahora el estado de vacunación de su hijo para que esté preparado para un comienzo exitoso del próximo año escolar.
