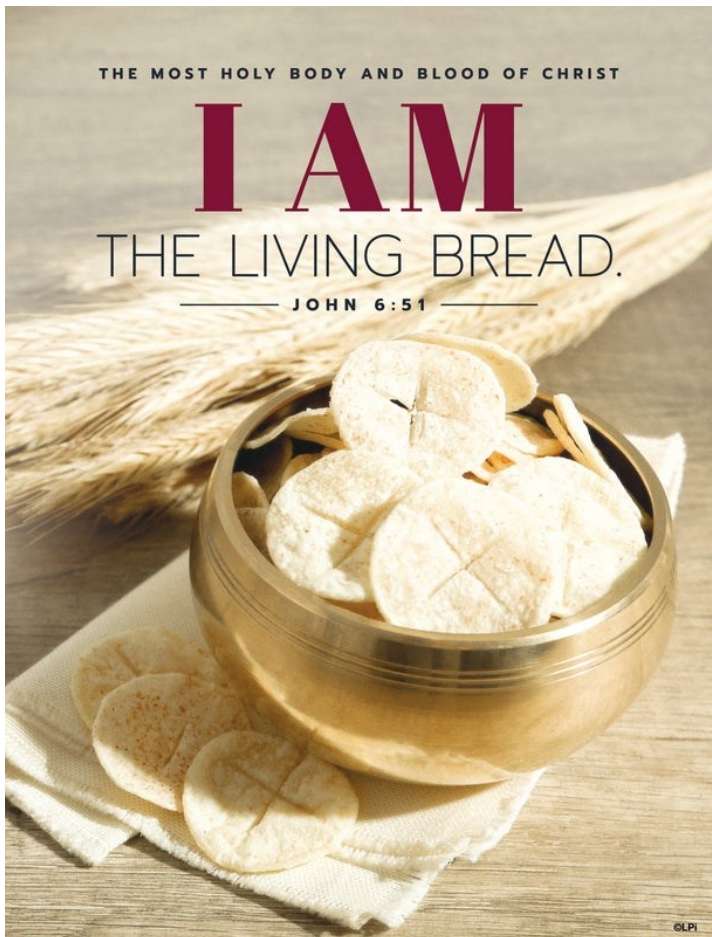



Behold the Lamb Quick Weekly Lessons on the Sacred Liturgy



As we exchange the *Sign of Peace* with one another, the Priest breaks the consecrated bread in the *Fraction Rite*. "The gesture of breaking bread done by Christ at the Last Supper...signifies that the many faithful are made one body (1 Cor 10:17) by receiving Communion from the one Bread of Life, which is Christ" (GIRM, 83). For the early Christians, this gesture gave the entire Eucharistic Action its name as we see the Eucharist synonymously referred to as the "breaking of the bread". Just as in ancient times, the breaking of bread by the head of a home signified the start of a meal, so too does the Priest, in *persona Christi*, signify the start of this heavenly meal which he is about to share with us.

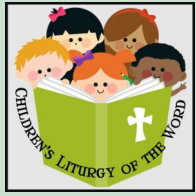
