Raider Athletes of the Month

May, 2026



The *Captivating Imagery* Female Athlete of the Month for May is senior thrower Addie Weaver. Addie had a stellar end to the track and field season as a javelin thrower. She qualified for the 2026 Western Pennsylvania Interscholastic League (WPIAL) Individual Championships and battled the elements to finish in second place with a throw of 132' 8". She moved onto the 2026 Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) Individual Championships and earned a bronze medal with a personal best throw of 141' 9", the second best javelin throw in Seneca Valley track and field history. For a month of outstanding performances, we recognize Addie as the May Female Athlete of the Month. Congratulations Addie!



The *Captivating Imagery* Male Athlete of the Month for May is track and field freshman Mitchell Everly. Mitchell blazed through the record books in his first year competing as a wheelchair athlete. His times and distances qualified him for the 2026 WPIAL Track and Field Individual Championships where he earned two golds (shotput and discus), one silver (400 meter) and one bronze (100 meter). Mitchell moved on to the PIAA Track and Field Individual Championships in all four events and came home a state champion in the shotput and discus and won silver and bronze medals in the 400 and 100 meters, respectively. Mitchell holds the Seneca Valley freshman records in wheelchair shotput (16' 1.5"), discus (45 3"), 100 meter (21.98) and 400 meter (1:28.49). For an impressive month, we recognize Mitchell as the May Male Athlete of the Month. Congratulations Mitchell!
