

Moline-Coal Valley District 40 to Destroy Student Permanent Records - LEGAL NOTICE

Pursuant to Illinois School Code 105 ILCS 10/4: Student Permanent Records, students who have graduated, transferred or permanently withdrawn from Moline-Coal Valley District 40 on or before June 1, 1966 will be destroyed no earlier than July 15, 2026.

"Student Permanent Record" means the minimum personal information necessary to a school in the education of the student and contained in a school student record. Such information may include the student's name, birth date, address, grades and grade level; parents' or guardians' names and addresses, attendance records; a summary of performance for students that received special education services; and such other entries as the State Board may require or authorize. A summary of performance shall be substantially similar to the summary of performance form developed by the State Board.

The school district shall maintain student permanent records and the information contained in those records for not less than 60 years after the student has transferred, graduated, or otherwise withdrawn from the school.

Any person whose permanent school record with the Moline-Coal Valley School District is scheduled for July 2026 destruction shall be given an opportunity to copy the record and information proposed to be destroyed or deleted.
