Wonder

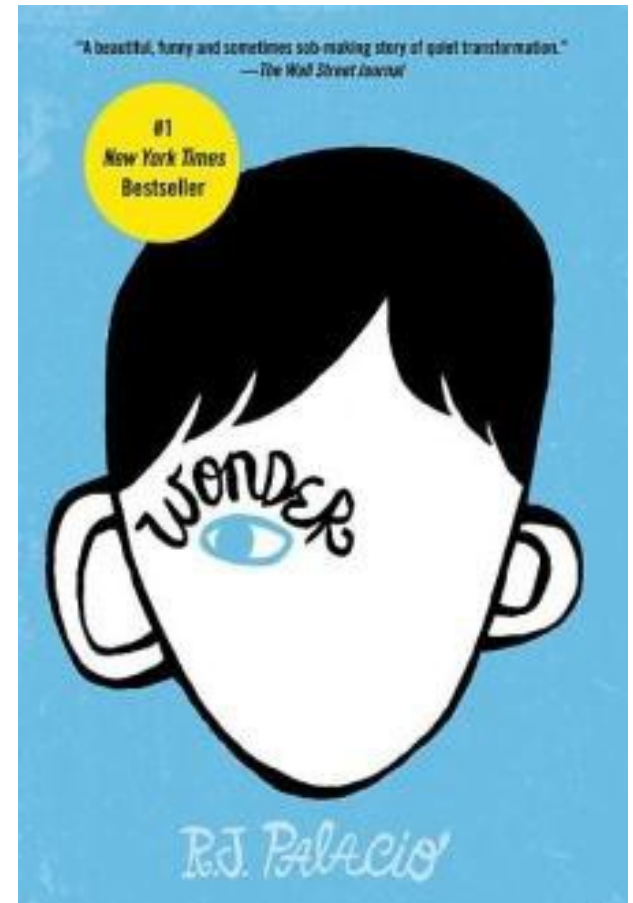
