

El's Summer Reading Activity: Get "SPOTTED" Reading a Great Book This Summer!

DIRECTIONS:

1. "Hunt" for some great summer titles on your reading level at your local library or bookstore.
2. Ask a family member or friend to take a photograph of you reading a book that you were "wild" about.
 - **PHOTOGRAPHS should be no larger than 3"x5"**
3. Fill out a copy of the attached summer reading activity sheet.
 - Write your name and the grade you will be entering.
 - Neatly attach your 3"x5" photograph in the box.
 - Share what you thought about your book on the provided lines.
4. Fold the paper into **3 sections** so that your photograph is in the center. It should now fit into a **legal sized envelope**.
5. Address your envelope to your building principal:
