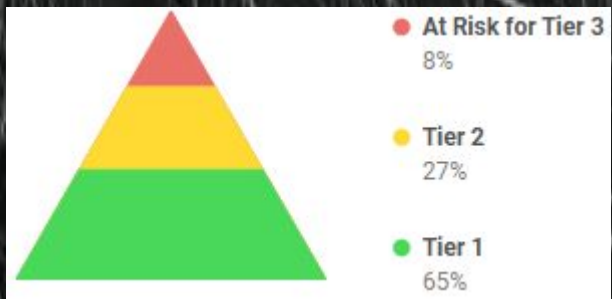
Reading - May 2025



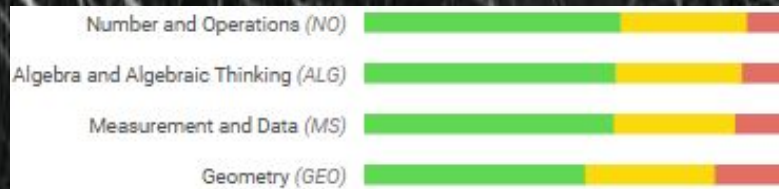
Reading - May 2026
