- earn and maintain a 3.0 GPA (out of 4.0) based on 2 previous semesters
- maintain an excellent record of behavior on and off the Dunedin Highland Middle School campus
- participate in leadership roles in school and/or community activities.
- agree to pay \$20 membership dues that cover cost of induction, chapter fees, and activities
- complete a required 10 hours of service to the campus and/or community
- regularly attend monthly meetings
