 BE MINDFUL Be mindful when scheduling family trips or doctor's appointments	 PROACTIVE Make sure to be proactive and get a doctor's note when applicable	 ENCOURAGE Share why school is important and encourage your child's attendance	 PRIORITIZE Prioritize school
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It's the Law.

State law requires students to attend at least 90 percent of the time a class is scheduled to meet. If student attendance is less than 90 percent, the student will lose credit unless school days are made up in accordance with a plan put in place by the principal.

- ✔ That means a student can only miss 18 days of school or 18 days of a specific class.
- ✔ At the high school level, students may lose credit on the 10th absence of the semester.

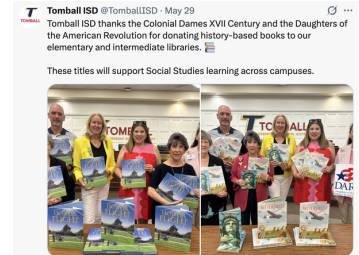
