228. STUDENT GOVERNMENT	
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee acknowledges the importance of offering students the opportunity to participate in self government within the school.
2. Authority SC 511, 1850.1	<p>The Joint Operating Committee establishes that students shall have the right to organize, conduct meetings, elect officers and representatives, and petition the Joint Operating Committee.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee will recognize the Climate Control Council as the official voice of the student body.</p> <p>The charter, constitution or bylaws of the organization for student government shall be duly adopted by the members of the student body it represents and approved by the Joint Operating Committee.</p>
SC 511	The Joint Operating Committee shall appoint a qualified member of the faculty to serve as an advisor for student government activities.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Director or designee shall establish rules and regulations to implement this policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Invite the participation of students in their formulation. 2. Assure that all students have equal access to the student government and an equal opportunity to vote and hold office.
SC 511 Pol. 618	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Require fiscal accountability and adherence to Joint Operating Committee policy for all financial aspects of student government activity.
