

# Student Dress

Students shall observe modesty, appropriateness, and neatness in clothing and personal appearance. Any clothing, cosmetics, tattoos, jewelry, contact lenses, hair, or style thereof shall not be worn, nor allowed to be worn, at school or at school-sponsored or school-related activities if it is a disturbing influence and/or interferes with the purposes of such classes or activities.

Clothing Item	Permitted Styles	Special Comments
Tops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any collared shirt</li> <li>• Solid or patterned shirt</li> <li>• Pull over sweater/sweatshirt</li> <li>• Turtleneck and mock turtleneck</li> <li>• Corsicana ISD spirit shirt</li> <li>• Any top with a college, university, or military logo</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chest area must be covered</li> <li>• All multi-layers must comply with dress code</li> <li>• No spandex or other stretch material</li> <li>• No tank tops or spaghetti straps</li> <li>• All shirts must extend below the hip line and overlap pants</li> <li>• No sheer or see-through material</li> <li>• All undergarments must be covered</li> </ul>
Bottoms/Shorts /Capris	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be in solid color (khaki, gray, navy, black, or various shades of denim)</li> <li>• Allowable pants include jeans, slacks, sweatpants</li> <li>• Shorts permitted no more than 2" above the knee</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All pants must be worn above the hip level (no sagging)</li> <li>• No holes and no skin showing above the knee</li> <li>• If belts are worn, they must be always worn inside belt loops and be the appropriate size</li> <li>• No studs, brads, or other excessive adornment on belts</li> <li>• Must be hemmed properly at bottom</li> <li>• No cutoffs, boxer shorts, pajamas, leggings, tights, bike shorts, athletic shorts that are shorter than 2 inches above the knee are not permitted</li> </ul>
Skirts/Dresses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hem of skirt or kick pleat must be no more than 2" above the kneecap</li> <li>• Dresses must have sleeves</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be hemmed properly at bottom</li> <li>• Dresses - chest area must be covered</li> <li>• Leggings and tights may be worn under skirts as long as guidelines for skirts are met.</li> </ul>

Outerwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sweatshirt</li> <li>• Jacket, Coat, Windbreaker</li> <li>• School-sponsored jacket</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No hoodies</li> <li>• No trench coats</li> <li>• No hats</li> </ul>
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must wear shoes</li> <li>• High school students can wear athletic sandals with socks</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No house shoes (shoes without soles)</li> <li>• No flip flops</li> <li>• No shoes with wheels</li> <li>• All students must wear closed-toed athletic shoes to PE</li> </ul>
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clothing, jewelry, or tattoos which displays or advertises controlled substances, such as alcohol, tobacco, or drugs, or that is lewd and offensive, or obscene is prohibited (weapons, drug or alcohol related)</li> <li>• No gang-related clothing or anything that may be allusive to gang-like affiliation, even if it is not on purpose No chains or bandanas</li> <li>• All clothing must fit appropriately, not excessively tight or large</li> </ul>	

Administrators will have complete and final judgment on all matters concerning interpretation of the dress code. Matters concerning appearance and dress not specifically covered in the dress code that are disruptive to the educational process are not permitted. \*\*For parents and guardians seeking accommodations for student dress based on their cultural practices or religious beliefs, please contact the school principal.
