**REGISTRATION INFORMATION:**

- Students who need to take a summer school course will be automatically enrolled and will be contacted by the guidance department regarding their registration.
- Schedules will be available for pick-up at the High School on July 2<sup>nd</sup> between 12 pm – 1:30 pm

**ATTENDANCE POLICY:** Research has shown that your child's regular attendance may be the greatest factor influencing his/her academic success. Since there are only 25 days of summer school, missing 2-3 days of school will negatively impact your child's academic performance. Therefore, the attendance policy for summer school is:

- A maximum of three (3) absences are permitted.
- Tardiness of fewer than 15 minutes is counted as ½ absence.
- Tardiness of more than 15 minutes is counted as a full day absence.
- There are no excused absences.
- Students with more than three (3) absences in a course will be dropped from that course.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- All bicycles are required to be locked to the bicycle rack located at the 300 building entrance.
- School I.D. cards must be worn at all times and shown to enter the building.
- All Code of Conduct policies are in effect during summer school. Students must adhere to the Code of Conduct. If a student violates the Code of Conduct during Summer School, it can result in immediate removal from the program.
- Students are responsible for their own transportation to summer school.
