On June 27, 2026, District 52 residents will vote whether to renew school funding to support their schools. If approved, the funding would address the maintenance of the school buildings and equipment. This funding would also provide funds for classroom materials, basic supplies for the school, and the upkeep of the campus grounds.

PROPOSITION

(Millage Renewal)

Shall Consolidated School District Number 52 of Rapides Parish, Louisiana, (the "District"), **continue to levy** a special tax of 6.96 mills on all property subject to taxation in the District (an estimated \$687,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of 10 years, beginning with the year 2027 and ending with the year 2036, for the purpose of constructing, improving, maintaining and/or operating the public schools and public school system in the District?
