



ALCOTT ELEMENTARY – JUNE 2026 CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Dear Students, Families and Neighbors,

The Alcott construction team is excited to build your new school, and we want to tell you what’s been happening on the job site!

WHAT WE’VE FINISHED:

- Dug big areas in the ground where the school’s base will go.
- Started setting up the spaces where concrete will be poured to make a strong foundation.

WHAT WE’RE WORKING ON NOW:

- Building a safe driveway so the construction trucks can come and go.
- Creating the shapes for the school’s base and adding strong steel bars (called rebar) to make it sturdy.
- Installing more pipes and wires underground for water, electricity and other important systems.

WHAT’S COMING UP NEXT:

- Getting ready for special inspections to make sure everything is safe and built the right way.

- Pouring concrete into the prepared areas and shaping it to form the school’s foundation.



SAFETY TIPS:

- Trucks come 4–5 days a week between 7:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Stay back and make sure drivers can see you.
- Listen to flaggers – they help keep everyone safe.
- Don’t go inside fenced-off areas.
- Tell an adult if you see something strange near the construction site.



IMPORTANT INFO:

WORKING HOURS

Standard work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., Monday–Friday.

We may need to work at night or weekends. Working hours will be in compliance with King County ordinances.

NOISE & VIBRATION

Backup alarms must stay on for safety per Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WISHA).

DELIVERIES

Trucks enter from 228th Ave. NE on the west side of the job site.

CLEAN WATER

The team makes sure that only clean rain water leaves the site.

WORKER RULES

All workers must follow Cornerstone and Lake Washington School District’s job site policies and safety rules.
