## CAMP DETAILS

**DATES:** July 26–29, 2026

(Drop-off Sunday, Pick-up Wednesday mid-day)

**AGES:** 16 and older

**COST:** \$950 per session Includes all meals, snacks, activities, art supplies, t-shirt, and memory book mailed home after camp

**ACTIVITIES:** Swimming, crafts, music, climbing, archery, and traditional camp programs

**STAFFING:** 1:4 staff-to-camper ratio with trained counselors and an on-site nurse

## ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION

Campers must be able to independently manage feeding, dressing, toileting, and grooming. Families may bring a personal caregiver if 1:1 support is needed.

Registration is by application only:

1. Join the waitlist and complete the pre-registration form
2. Meet with a camp leader to confirm fit
3. Finalize enrollment through CampMinder

Payment options: Full pay, DDCS provider funding, and campership scholarships available — no one will be turned away for lack of funds.
