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Dear Parents and Families,

As we approach the end of the academic year, students across Harnett County Schools will soon participate in the state-mandated End-of-Grade (EOG) assessments in reading, math, and science. These important assessments will be administered during the final 10 days of the school year, from **May 11 to May 22, 2026**. Each school will share the specific testing dates for your child's grade level and subjects.

All EOG assessments will be conducted online. Students are required to participate in-person at their school. To help your child feel confident and prepared, we encourage you to ensure they get plenty of rest the night before each test and start their day with a healthy breakfast. Punctuality is essential, so please help your child arrive at school on time for each testing session.

Additionally, we kindly ask that you talk with your child about **leaving cell phones and electronic devices at home** during the testing period. According to State Testing Assessment Guide:

"Students are not allowed to have in their possession or use cell phones or any other electronic devices at any time during testing, including breaks. Any person found or observed with a cell phone/electronic device during testing must be dismissed from testing, and a misadministration may be declared."
