

Title I Parent Involvement Plan Anderson Creek Primary School

Anderson Creek Primary School believes that a strong home and school partnership is essential for student success and we actively seek to involve parents as our partners. We will work toward achieving the following parent involvement goals:

- *Inform* – We will introduce parents to the Title I program, explaining the requirements and their rights as parents. We will provide a curriculum night to inform parents about Leader in Me leadership principles, Common Core/Essential Standards, assessments to measure student progress and proficiency and the levels that students are expected to meet. The state academic standards will be provided during orientations, meetings, conferences, and activities. We will provide individual conferences with parents and we will schedule meetings with parents to provide resources, conferences, or activities to address individual student needs. We will hold parent meetings and conferences at different times during the day, and advertise them well in advance. Students will receive a handbook during the first week of school.
- *Communicate* – We will provide parents with timely information about the School Improvement Plan. We will use school/classroom newsletters, report cards, calendars, “alert now” phone calls, and the school website to give current information. When needed, we will use teachers, technology, or training to provide assistance in understanding state standards and assessments. Information about school meetings, parent programs, and associated activities will be sent to participating children in a form and language that parents can understand. Counselors, ESL teachers, social workers, administrators and a resource center will be available where required.
- *Involve* – We will create opportunities for parents to participate at school including field trips, parent/grandparent luncheons, Parents will be encouraged to volunteer, participating in a wide range of school activities and learning experiences. Volunteers will be approved following district policy including a background check.
- *Plan* - Parents will serve as elected representatives on the SIT, planning and reviewing our Parent Involvement Policy and School Improvement Plan. Parent surveys will be used to inform decisions about school programs. We will budget Title I funds to support expenses associated with parent involvement activities.
- *Partner* – We will provide a School/Parent/Student Compact to students in the fall which outlines how everyone will share in the responsibility for improved student achievement. Parents can monitor student attendance, homework completion and screen time at home to improve achievement.
