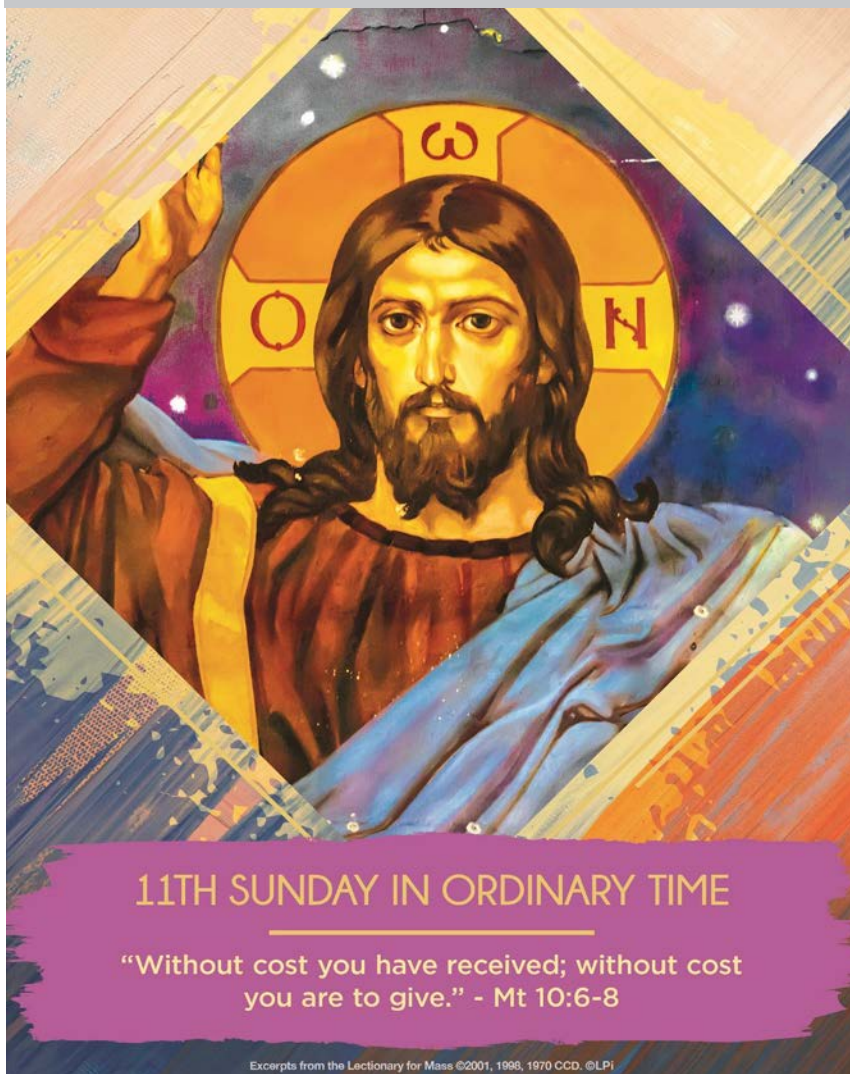

The Gist with Fr. Jeremy



Hi Everyone, I want to give a quick promo. Some Divine Child alumni who are good friends of mine: Joe Biscaro and Tom Papich along with their band, The Taildraggers, (including DC alumnus Tim Braum) are going to be doing a live music gig, playing some lively blues music, at Kelly's Irish Pub on Saturday, June 20. I think many of you might enjoy stopping by!

The next two weeks in the bulletin will be my opportunity to share some thank-you's from my time at Divine Child. This week, I want to start by thanking the wonderful priests that I have had the blessing to live and minister with.

I am very grateful to Fr. John for the two years we had together here. Fr. John and I spent many evenings having long conversations on our patio. His friendship was a great support, he also gave me a lot of direct encouragement for different ideas that I mentioned to him. Also, I learned so much about the reality of how Christian faith is lived in China, and that was an enormous gift that I will never forget.

I am also very grateful to Fr. Ryan. I feel like things never missed a beat when he took over for Fr. John. He too has been a great friend, and we have shared many wonderful conversations. I have especially enjoyed talking with him about Patristics, his area of study. He has been very selfless, always willing to cover a Mass or anything else. I dragged him into a lot of extra work asking him for help with things, and he was always very generous. Fr. Ryan and I have prayed a lot of the breviary together, which has been another great blessing.

Finally, I cannot say enough about how blessed I am to have had this time living with, ministering with, and learning from Fr. Bob McCabe. There are so many ways this relationship has blessed me, but I will confine myself to mentioning four here. Fr. Bob does an amazing job of cultivating an atmosphere of community in the rectory. Besides the priests who live there all the time, our guest room is like a revolving door of different priests and seminarians coming to visit and stay for a bit. This is no accident. It is because many people have gotten clued into the fact that Fr. Bob is a welcoming and hospitable man, and that if you stay in his rectory it will be a very joyful and uplifting time. This communal atmosphere has greatly uplifted my spirits.

Secondly, Fr. Bob is full of both practical and spiritual wisdom, that applies in diverse areas such as parish administration or good advice to give out in the confessional. That wisdom is often expressed in pithy one-liners. Such as "Under-sell and over-deliver," or "Don't play games with God," I am going to take a lot of that wisdom with me

Thirdly, Fr. Bob has a servant's heart. Whenever he comes across anyone who needs anything, his first reaction and instinct is always to jump in and help, even at great cost to himself. I have seen him give heroic service to many

parishioners, to persons-in-need, and even to me! He makes me want to think of myself less, and that too is a great gift.

Finally, simply his joy. I have told Fr. Bob before that if I am as happy to be a priest as he is when I get to his age, then I will consider my life well-lived. Unfortunately, sometimes priests get bitter and cynical as they move through ministry. Fr. Bob has done the opposite. Like a fine wine he seems to have only become brighter and more merry. Perhaps the best witness of all that I, as a young priest could receive, was to spend my first assignment alongside an older priest who is still filled with joy. When I am tempted to bitterness and cynicism over the course of my ministry, I will forever remember Fr. Bob, and know that there is another and better way!

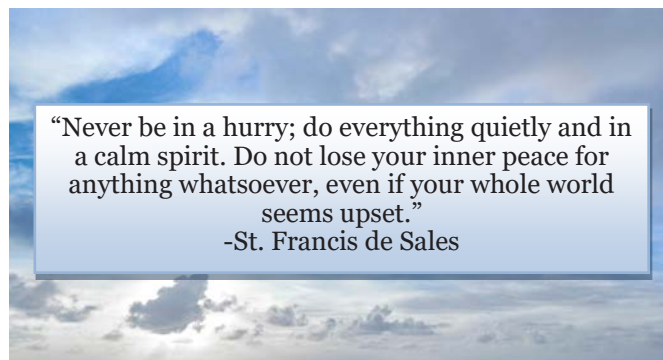
Fr. Jeremy will preside at the 4:30pm and 10:00am Masses, and will preach at all the Masses.

SAFE ENVIRONMENTS: Volunteer Requirements



UNITED STATES CONFERENCE OF
CATHOLIC BISHOPS



The Archdiocese of Detroit, in compliance with the USCCB Charter for Protection of Youth and Young People, **requires any and all parish and school volunteers to complete Protecting God's Children training and maintain a current background check, regardless of whether they are interfacing with children or vulnerable adults.** Please review the steps below to ensure you are in full compliance.

Create and/or login to VIRTUS Account

VIRTUS is the Church's online system for Protecting God's Children training and volunteer safety compliance. All information shared within VIRTUS is secure and encrypted for online security. Please visit **VIRTUS.org** to get started.

New users: Create an account.

Returning users: Log in with your current credentials to access courses, authorize background checks, recertify or update your information.

Quick tip: Keep your login handy for future training updates or renewals.

Authorize Background Check

Upon registering with VIRTUS, **new users** will provide their date of birth, gender, race, and confirm Michigan residency for the past 7 years, followed by signing and authorizing the background check.

Your VIRTUS account will show the check as cleared once it has been completed by our on-staff VIRTUS coordinator in strict confidentiality.

Review & Sign Volunteer Code of Conduct

All volunteers are required to read and sign the Volunteer Code of Conduct. This can be completed by logging into your VIRTUS account.

If needed, a paper copy may also be reviewed and signed; completion will be recorded in your VIRTUS account under the "Required Documents" tab.

All Divine Child parish and school volunteers - new and currently serving - are expected to complete all four steps prior to volunteering.

Sign up & Attend Protecting God's Children Training

Protecting God's Children (PGC) is a 3-hour awareness session that educates adults on how to recognize inappropriate or predatory behavior, take steps to prevent abuse, and report concerns responsibly.

First-time participants must attend an in-person *Protecting God's Children 4.0* session, while **anyone who completed PGC in 2022 or earlier** may complete a recertification online through the VIRTUS web training module (*Protecting God's Children 4.0* and *Vulnerable Adults 2.0*).

How to Register

All registration is completed online through your VIRTUS account. VIRTUS offers sessions across metro Detroit (see database in your account).

250 Hours of Adoration

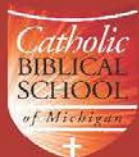

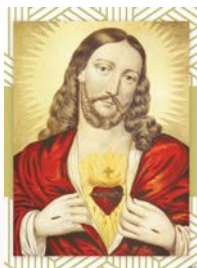

Guidelines:

DO:

Send stamps that:

- Have perforations intact,
- Are not too heavily canceled
- Are not torn, cut or stained.

Leave at least ¼-inch on each side of the stamp when cutting it from the envelope-- it will save you money when you send them

DON'T:

Waste your time, effort or money by sending stamps that are plentiful and have little or no resale value such as:

BEWARE: TRENDING SCAM ALERT

SWEETHEART SWINDLE/ROMANCE SCAM

A "sweetheart swindle" is a type of romance scam where a con artist builds a fake romantic relationship to gain the victim's trust and ultimately steal their money. These scams often occur online through dating sites or social media, involve fake profiles, and a scammer will consistently find excuses to avoid meeting in person while asking for financial help for emergencies or investments.

How it works

Fake profile: A scammer creates a fake online profile to initiate a relationship with the victim.

Rapid emotional connection: They quickly profess love and build an emotional bond, often targeting lonely or isolated individuals.

Escalating requests for money: After gaining trust, the scammer starts asking for money for various "emergencies," such as medical bills, business ventures, or travel costs.

Avoids meeting in person: The scammer always has a reason to not meet in person, and the relationship remains virtual.

Final plea: The requests for money become more desperate and frequent until the victim's funds are exhausted.

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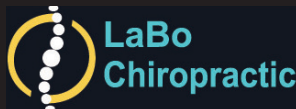


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
