
For English Learner (EL) families, classes will align with the elementary and middle school schedules. Our EL staff will be reaching out to families directly to provide further information.

Attention all Juniors: The PSAT will be offered at North High School this October!

The PSAT will be offered at Appleton North High School on Friday October 30th, 2026. Please note that this is a non-school day and you will need to provide your own transportation. The PSAT is the practice SAT, and is used as the qualifier for the National Merit Scholarship Program. Juniors that wish to take this optional test can register in the School Counseling Office when school begins. To complete a registration, students will need to bring their Appleton North student ID along with \$20 to reserve a seat for test day. If you plan to pay by check, please make the check out to Appleton North High School.
