

Summary

The School Improvement Team meeting focused on preparing for the 2026-27 school year at Rocky River. Dr. Stitt outlined the five focus areas (B303, D102, C201, A401, E106) that will guide next year's improvement efforts, with action steps centered on calibrated instructional walkthroughs, data-driven protocols, and targeted interventions for 9th grade students. The team completed the required Title 1 Annual Review, with all attendees reviewing the document and submitting feedback forms. Athletics updates were minimal as most activities have concluded for the current term.

- The five focus areas for 2026-27 (B303, D102, C201, A401, E106) will remain unchanged, with action steps centered on IST-led instructional walkthroughs, data protocols, and targeted 9th grade interventions.

2026-27 Focus Areas & Action Steps

- The five focus areas remain unchanged for next year: B303, D102, C201, A401, and E106, though specific action steps are subject to change based on end-of-year results.
- B303 focuses on the Instructional Support Team implementing a calibrated walkthrough system with actionable feedback cycles and structured data analysis protocols aligned to EOC standards.
- D102 and related indicators emphasize aligning MCLs to coaching cycles, implementing Solution Tree training protocols, and using IST walkthrough tools to systematically collect and analyze instructional data.
- A401 provides targeted intervention for 9th grade students performing below grade level using iReady diagnostics, contracted tutoring services, and in-school supports aligned to Math 1 and other high-need areas.
- Many action steps are targeted toward the Instructional Support Team and build upon the professional development foundation established this year, launching off anticipated strong end-of-year performance.

Title 1 Annual Review

- The School Improvement Team completed the required end-of-year Title 1 Annual Review, with team members reviewing the document and providing feedback through an online form.
- All attendees successfully reviewed the Title 1 documentation and submitted their feedback forms, fulfilling the compliance requirement.
