Key Actions Taken	In preparation for the BOCES Capital Project, the District created a BOCES Capital Fund which allows us to save for future payments. The Board also voted to authorize the creation of a Workers' Compensation Reserve. In addition, the Board voted to set not-to-exceed limits on deposits to reserve accounts that will be replenished at the close of the 2025-26 fiscal year.
