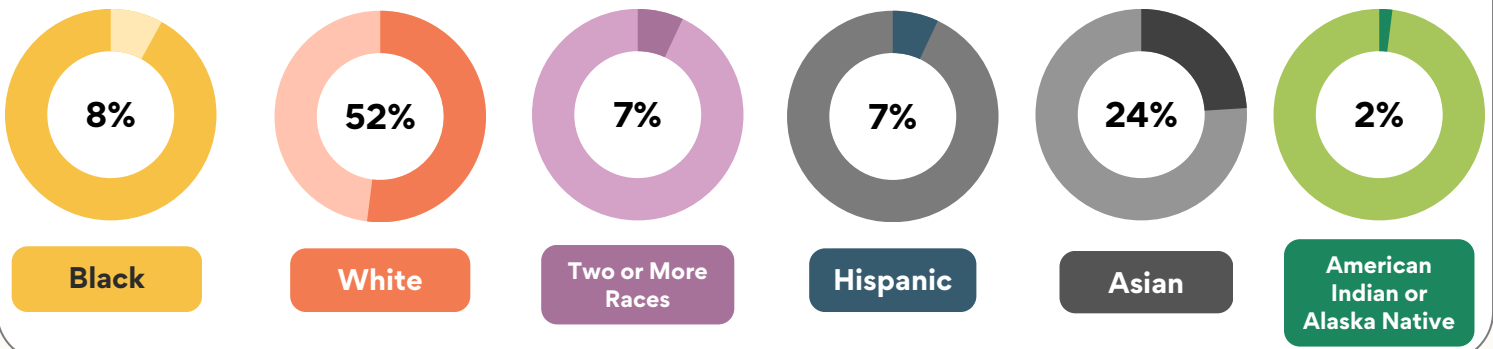

Mission statement: The mission of Grove Elementary School is to create a nurturing, rigorous, and safe learning environment that meets the needs of our diverse student population.

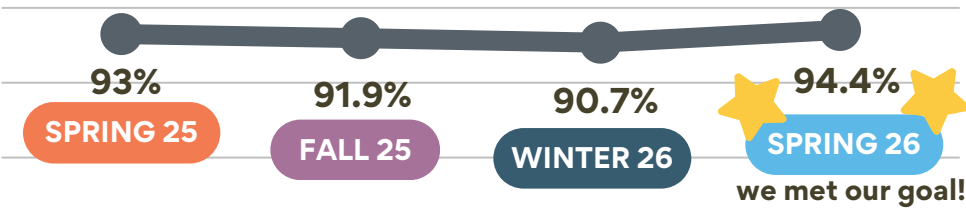

Literacy Goal

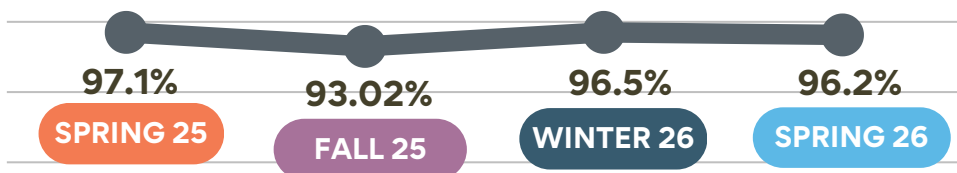


During the 2025–2026 school year, our goal is for 94% of our student population to be reading at or above grade level as measured by the Fountas & Pinnell Literacy Assessment.

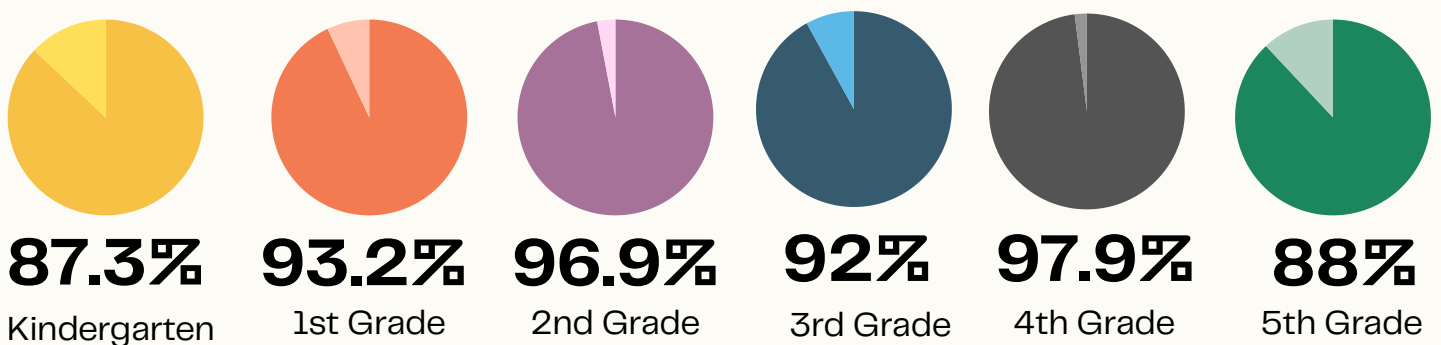
