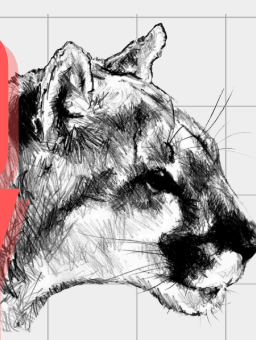

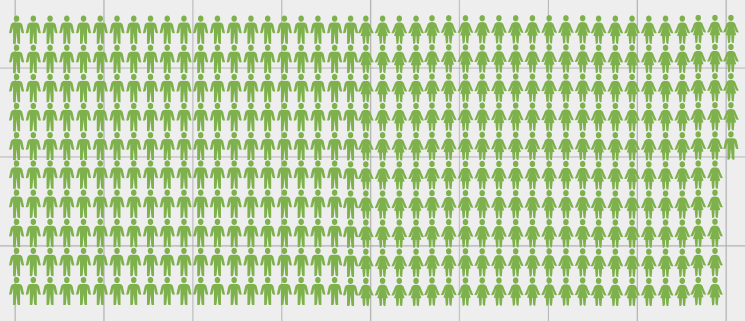

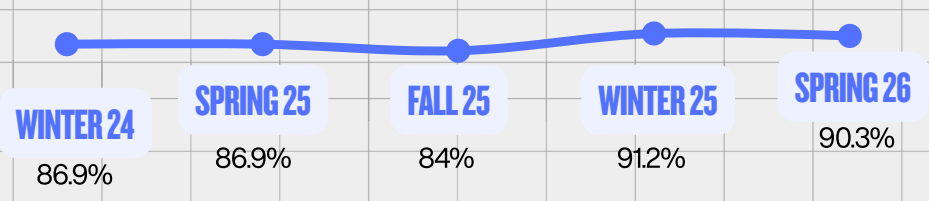

During the 2025-2026 school year, our goal is to increase student performance in math by improving STAR math assessment meets and exceeds scores by 3% from fall to spring.

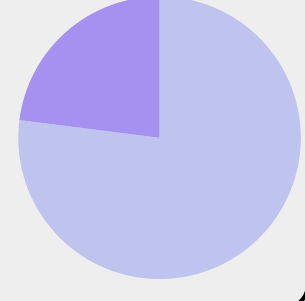
