Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

Welcome to EASTERN's Allied Health Program. This program is designed for students who plan to continue their post-secondary schooling in a health-related field. The students will have job shadowing opportunities. We are expecting to go to Christ's Home this year for clinical experiences based on availability. These experiences provide students with opportunities to explore various health careers and help students with their future post-secondary career paths. It is expected that the students will behave in a mature, professional manner always since they will be dealing with patients, doctors, nurses, and other health care professionals. Clinical experiences are optional.

Job shadowing sites have strict appearance policies, and we follow these policies without exception. Failure to adhere to these appearance policies will exclude you from the site. Adherence to the school policies as written in the school handbook, compliance with the site and program policies, and compliance with the requirements are mandatory to provide the foundation for the necessary health care profession skills, attitudes, and behaviors. Due to the nature and academic demands of this program, students must complete or be taking Algebra I and II, College Prep Biology with a lab, and College Prep Chemistry with a lab. Please discuss it with your counselor.

To assure that students are ready to begin the program in September, we are providing information concerning the program and its requirements. Student uniforms will be needed for the classroom and clinical experiences. I suggest students buy the EASTERN Allied Health black jacket with their uniform as no sweatshirts are allowed in class for lab or clinical. We are contracted with SLOM's Professional Uniforms. Uniforms will be required by the second week of school, so please order early to ensure delivery. Please mention the EASTERN Allied Health Program for uniform selections.

All forms and information you will need to meet these requirements are enclosed for your convenience. All requirements must be met for acceptance into the program. We ask that students obtain their PA State and Child Abuse Clearances and all immunization requirements before the start of the school year. **The completed forms must be returned to EASTERN by Tuesday, September 15, 2026.** We have also enclosed some general information and a program cost sheet for your convenience.

In addition, the Allied Health program will offer the opportunity for students to enroll in college classes at Montgomery County Community College. We will offer Medical Terminology and Medical Law and Ethics courses for dual enrollment credits. The textbooks for each of these classes will need to be ordered and purchased by the students.

The following textbooks are needed for class:

Medical Terminology: *Building a Medical Vocabulary with Spanish Translations 11th Edition*, by Peggy C. Leonard. This should be a new paperback workbook as it will be filled in as we learn in class and is needed by September 15th.

Medical Law and Ethics: *Medical Law and Ethics 6th Edition*, by Bonnie F. Fremgen. This is needed by the 2nd week in January 2027.

Students can purchase these textbooks from anywhere. I put up the Amazon links because they are usually the cheapest and make it easier to order. I would purchase early as it will get more expensive and less available to purchase once college classes start in August.

Medical Terminology HCP 224 Course

- This course is offered through Montgomery County Community College at EASTERN in the Fall 2026.
- More information will be provided on this opportunity once school resumes this Fall.
- You will earn 3 College Credits.
- The cost to you for these courses is approximately \$230 per 3 credit dual enrollment course.

- **You MUST earn a minimum grade of “B” to earn the 3 credits to transfer through MCCC (grade scale B=83 to 85%) and at least a “C” (70 to 75%) to achieve a Certificate of Completion for the Allied Health Program**
- This course is very much like taking a Foreign Language – it is complex and challenging.
- Registration for this course will take place in fall, and MCCC will bill you directly.
- MCCC requires a minimum enrollment of 10 students to provide the dual enrollment course at EASTERN. If minimum enrollment is not met, the course will not be offered.

Medical Law and Ethics MAS 114 Course

- This course is offered through Montgomery County Community College at EASTERN in the Spring 2027.
- More information will be provided on this opportunity once school resumes this Fall.
- You will earn 3 College Credits.
- The cost to you for these courses is approximately \$230 per 3 credit dual enrollment course.

- **You MUST earn a minimum grade of “B” to earn the 3 credits to transfer through MCCC (grade scale B=83 to 85%) and at least a “C” (70 to 75%) to achieve a Certificate of Completion for the Allied Health Program**
- Registration for this course will take place in fall or spring, and MCCC will bill you directly.
- MCCC requires a minimum enrollment of 10 students to provide the dual enrollment course at EASTERN. If minimum enrollment is not met, the course will not be offered.

Uniforms:

- All students must be in complete uniform to attend job shadowing or be in the Allied Health Lab.
- You will need to purchase the clinical uniform from EASTERN approved provider –SLOM’s Professional Uniforms, 1125 Old York Road Abington, PA 19001
- It is recommended to order 2 pairs of pants, 2 tops, and 1 jacket.
- The **classroom and clinical uniforms** will be black pants, green tops (with EASTERN Logo), black lab jacket (with EASTERN Logo)
- You will also need to purchase a pair of all black or white clinical shoes/sneakers. They must be leather – no canvas, suede, or nylon. All shoes must be clean at all times.
- Failure to be in appropriate uniform will preclude you from attending clinical and working in the lab.
- You may wear either a **white or black short/long sleeved T-shirt** under the uniform shirt. **NO Hoodies will be allowed to be worn.**

Clinical Shadowing Requirements:

ALL Clearances, Immunizations, and Physical must be completed prior to the start of school!

- Pennsylvania State Police Criminal History Record (cost is \$22.00 – done on-line)
Completion and submission of the “Request for Criminal Record Check.” Applicant to log onto: <https://epatch.state.pa.us> and select “submit a new record check.”
- Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance (cost is \$13.00 – done on-line)
Completion and submission of the “Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance”. This can be done online (<https://www.compass.state.pa.us/CWIS>). Select “create a new account” and enter profile information.
- Physical listing all immunizations (Form to be provided by EASTERN)
- Current PPD (Must be done AFTER JUNE 1, 2026)
- Current FLU VACCINE – must be for the 2026-2027 Flu Season due September 15, 2026.
- Covid 19 immunization will be required as well as boosters if needed to show proof of vaccination.
- Documentation of Physical, PPD, immunization record, and Flu will be due at EASTERN by September 15, 2026.
- CPR/AED/First Aid for Health Care Providers (training and certification will take place at EASTERN in January 2027 through the Emergency Safety and Care Institute (ESCI).
- **Per Clinical Dress Code: No Crocs, No Dangle Earrings, Necklaces, Rings, Facial Piercings, No Acrylic or Gel Nails, No Visible Tattoos**
- **Failure to meet any of the above-listed clinical requirements will preclude you from attending clinical at the health facilities.**

Step 1: (YEAR 1 ONLY) Students need to Log into the “Remind” app: (This will make it possible to communicate with you and your student about assignments, scholarships, job openings, and catering we might be doing.)

Step 2: Buy/Order Kitchen Shoes: You are **required** to wear oil resistant non-skid, black footwear every day in the lab area. Other kinds of shoes are **not permitted** in the culinary arts lab, for safety. (SEE BELOW)

Step 3: Buy/Order Culinary Uniform: Chef uniform (chef jacket, chef pants, chef hat, & apron) must be worn **at all times** in the culinary arts lab. Uniforms must be cleaned regularly (dirty uniforms = loss of daily grade and germs). Regular clothes are prohibited in the culinary arts lab, for safety. (SEE BELOW)

Step 4: Bring all above materials and Laptop/Chromebook (charged) to EASTERN everyday. Almost all assignments and the student’s notebook will be on EASTERN’s Microsoft “Teams” account that all students will be provided with while here at EASTERN. It is important that they bring their device every day. Cell phones are good in a pinch but not for every day.

This is recommended to help keep students from losing their uniforms. *There may be a two-four week turnaround for uniform orders.* (Please write the student’s name in ALL other clothing articles as well.)

Since we begin hands-on activities immediately at the beginning of the school year, please purchase your uniforms prior to the start of the school year.

All students must be in full uniform by the second week of school. Students must have a full uniform and safe work shoes in order to work in the kitchen. Failure to meet these requirements will result in a loss of Employability Grade.

The chefs’ uniform has certain utilitarian aspects relating to safety and sanitation but also represents pride and professionalism. All students enrolled in the Culinary Arts Program will wear CLEAN uniforms EVERYDAY with pride and professionalism!

Design, Photography and Illustration

Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning

Shop Requirements:

- Work clothes and shoes are required.

Networking and Cybersecurity

REQUIRED MATERIALS FOR CLASS

The following supplies and documentation are required to complete the NETWORKING AND CYBERSECURITY course:

- MCCC Dual Enrollment (optional) - 4-three credit courses approx. \$230.00 each

NETWORKING AND CYBERSECURITY is a dual enrollment program. You can earn up to 12 college credits from Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) at 1/3 the cost of regular student tuition plus books. These credits transfer to most major colleges and universities. You will also have an opportunity to obtain industry certifications in this program.

We also have an agreement with Penn State Abington that any qualified student from this program will be given preferential admission into their four-year major in Information Sciences and Technology (IST) and the admissions application cost will be paid for by Penn State Abington.

Instructor will provide directions and payment information for certifications and dual enrollment during the school year.

Dress Code Requirements:

- You are expected to look and act as a professional
- Business casual attire is required.
- No workout clothes, pajamas, slippers, sweatpants, hoodies, ripped jeans, inappropriate shirts, flip flops, slide sandals or shorts (after October 1), etc.

Protective Services

Protective Services

REQUIRED MATERIALS FOR CLASS

The following supplies and documentation are required to complete the PROTECTIVE SERVICES Program of Instruction:

- **Black or Blue Ink Pens, Pencils.**
 - Students are not permitted to use red pens for class assignments.
 - Students will be required to attend class prepared.
- **Large loose-leaf notebook.**
 - Loose-leaf notebooks and notes taken during class need to be organized.
 - Notes could be graded during the program.
- **Pocket notepad**
 - Should fit into the back or side pocket of the uniform pants.
- **Wristwatch** (analog not digital)
- **Lightweight Stethoscope** – (will be used during the EMS session of the class)
- **Duty Uniform:**
 - The Protective Services uniform will be worn daily by the student.
 - Not wearing the uniform will result in losing Daily Employability points which will impact the student's overall grade.
 - Duty uniform (Black Polo Shirt with the class emblem, Tan Pants, Black Boots) is the uniform for the class. This uniform will identify the students of this class.
 - Uniform shirts can be purchased at Slom's Professional Uniforms.
 - The parts of the uniform are indicated on the spreadsheet enclosed with this letter. Men's and women's uniforms are the same. You will need a credit card and a personal email address to order uniforms. To order uniforms go to <https://www.slomsuniforms.com/eastern-protective-services/5234514/c>. Also, black sweatshirts and t-shirts can be ordered to be used as Physical Fitness clothing but are not mandatory to be ordered from the vendor.
 - **Hooded Sweatshirts are not permitted in class.**
 - Order the uniforms as soon as possible as it takes between 3-6 weeks for shipping of completed orders. Any issues please contact the vender.

Purchase Items (or comparable):

- Black, Polyester/cotton Uniform Shirt – Short Sleeve (EASTERN does have class patches for purchase)
- Tan, tactical trousers
- 1.5-inch Duty Belt
- Boots 8-inch-high. (No boots lower than 3 inches are acceptable and none higher than 8-inch)

Protective Services

Local Purchase Items:

- 2 Black T-Shirts – Crew Neck [worn with Physical Training]. Physical training, (PT), is usually 2 times per week. No writing on T-shirts unless using the T-shirts ordered through Slom's Professional Uniforms store for the program with the Protective Services emblem.
- Performance Shorts, 9-inch inseam, maximum length 7-inch inseam minimum length (both male and female), no writing on shorts unless ordered through the school store.
- White or Black athletic socks
- Running/athletic shoes

Optional uniform items include a long sleeve matching color undershirt that can be worn under the uniform shirt. This can be ordered through any vendor, but the sleeves should not have any writing or images.

**Physical fitness training and physical fitness are part of the program of instruction. Students will receive an initial assessment and the students will be partnering with the Exercise Science and Rehabilitation class to create a baseline/plan for each student. Physical fitness training will be conducted typically bi-weekly with the intent of progressive improvement. This will include push-ups, sit-ups, walking, running, pull-ups, chin-ups, weightlifting and other exercises.

4. Complete the purchase and a proper shipping address for the items.
5. Notify Mr. Raggi at MRaggi@eastech.org of your purchase, the student's name for the purchase and a telephone number he can reach you at if there are any issues. Similarly, provide an email address to Mr. Raggi.
6. Await the delivery of the uniform items. Please be aware the order time can be more than 4 weeks for delivery. If the uniform does not arrive in time the student will wear the PT uniform.
