- D. Approve resolution: WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Wyoming Central School District established a Reserve for

Repairs Fund in accordance with General Municipal Law 6-d in 2018; and WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined that the remaining funds in such Reserve for Repairs Fund are no longer necessary for their intended purpose; and WHEREAS, the Board of Education established a Reserve for State and Local Retirement System Contributions Fund in accordance with General Municipal Law 6-r in 2011 to which it desires to transfer funds; and WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of General Municipal Law 6-r, the Board of Education held a duly noticed public hearing on June 11, 2026 regarding the transfer of such funds. NOW, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby authorizes the transfer of \$340,435.27 to the District's Retirement Contribution Reserve Fund established pursuant to General Municipal Law 6-r.

- E. Based upon the recommendations of the superintendent the Board of Education authorizes an increase of \$210,000.00 to the appropriations code A9901.900-00-0000 (Capital Projects Transfer) to be transferred from the following accounts, in lieu of issuing debt for the BOCES capital project:
 - \$110,000.00 from A9060.800-00-0000 (Medical Insurance)
 - \$50,000.00 from A5540.400-00-0000 (Contract Transportation)
 - \$50,000.00 from A2250.470-00-0000 (Tuition – Public Schools)

- F. On September 5, 2025 the District sustained the loss of a school zone sign. An insurance claim was filed, and Utica National reimbursed the District a sum of \$5,384, which includes the recovery of the \$500 deductible from the party who caused the damage. It is recommended that the Board of Education formally approve the following budgetary amendments:
 - Increase Budgetary Revenues A2680.1 (Insurance Recoveries – Other) by \$5,384.
 - Increase Budgetary Appropriations A1621.200-00-0000 (Maintenance of Plant – Equipment) by \$5,384.

- G. On March 25, 2026 the District filed an insurance claim with Utica National following property damage sustained on March 19, 2026 pursuant to a sewer backup into the main building. Utica National has valued the claim at \$11,807.55 less our \$5,000 deductible. It is recommended that the Board of Education formally approve the following budgetary amendments:
 - Increase Budgetary Revenues A2680.1 (Insurance Recoveries – Other) by \$6,807.55.
 - Increase Budgetary Appropriations by \$6,807.55, distributed as follows:
