- Web browser (Chrome recommended)
- PDF reader (Adobe Acrobat Reader recommended)
- Microsoft Office (provided by Oakwood at no cost, additional details provided first day of school)
- Allows installation of printers and software, as both may be required for class
- Compatible headphones/earbuds

Note to Parents

We recommend retaining an administrator account for yourself while your child operates from a non-administrator account. Retail outlets (not online retailers) can assist with setup questions at time of purchase.
