The committee convened the meeting at 4:04 p.m.

1. Framing the Work

Committee

The committee discussed a recent request for information regarding accessibility of artificial intelligence in each of our schools. Administration will provide the information at which time the committee will determine whether this information will influence the current construction of Policy 8636, and if so, whether this will require an additional first reading. Accordingly, the committee may not present Policy 8636 for a second reading on June 9.

The committee also discussed the recent NYSED notice that cited the district for disproportionality in the special education classification of students in the federally defined Hispanic subgroup. The special education committee previously discussed this information, and K. Slentz discussed the possible policy implications that may result from the work that the special education administration is doing with the New York State Education Department.

3. Policy Development

Committee

- a. Code of Conduct ([5300](#)) *Required*

The committee completed its initial review of the code of conduct. K. Slentz will make the revisions to each section and return the revised draft to the committee for review. The goal is to review the changes with the board over the summer, post the policy for public comment, and then adopt the policy in August.

The committee tabled this policy until the next meeting.

- d. Student Health Services (5420) *Recommended*

K. Slentz will review the dental certificate rules and practices and provide the information to the committee. Based on the information provided, the committee may move this to a first reading at the June 9 meeting.

e. Board Organizational Meeting (2210) *Recommended*

The committee will present this policy for a first reading at the June 9 meeting. Because of the time-sensitive nature of the policy's content, the committee will also recommend waiving the second reading and adopting the policy at the June 9 meeting.
