

Middle School Math Lab Syllabus

Course Description/Goals:

This course is designed to support students in meeting individual math goals necessary for achieving success in grade level coursework and on grade level STAAR. Instruction in this course will focus on deepening prior grade level math concepts that are aligned and necessary to achieve mastery on current grade level standards. Enrollment in this course requires campus administration approval and is concurrent with the grade level math class. NOTE: A required Math course may take the place of an elective for students scoring “Not Met” on the previous year’s STAAR test. This is a requirement under HB4545.

Course TEKS/Objectives:

The TEKS (Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills) in these classes are dependent on the individual learning needs of each student. The TEKS that are used in this class can range from 4th grade to 8th grade to help students close learning gaps. Prior grade level TEKS will be used to build student understanding to master grade level TEKS.
