 - B. We will complete a Summative Evaluation of our 25-26 District Improvement Plan and LEA Program Plan. Then we will complete the revision of those plans as they transform into our 26-27 plans.

- III. **Summative Evaluation of 25-26 Plans**

 1. Progress based on data that we have made toward each goal –
Student Success: Review of the Bullying policies, Staff Surveys, Student Surveys, Successful in Academic UIL, Athletics, Extra-Curricular, CTE programs
Teacher Recruitment: Leadership team meetings with staff and principals. Try and keep our staff happy and we will have happy kids also.
Competitive Pay for Staff: We have bumped our overall staff years of service to add an additional 5 years to the salary scale.

Faculty Staff Recruitment: TAC (Teacher Advisory Committee) has been established for the 2026-2027 school year to garner input from them.

Community Outreach: Several events were held throughout the year. Business partnership with the Union Grove Education Foundation. Inviting Community to speak with students at the Elementary Career Day. Homecoming and Veteran's Day events.

Financial: We have a new Superintendent and new Business manager working together to develop a budget for next year.

Operations: Transition to Jerry Croley who will be taking over as the Director of Facilities and Operations as of June 1st.

Facilities will be repaired and cleaned up over the Summer.
