



## 2026-2027 Uniform Information

A safe learning environment is the first requirement of a successful school. Young people who are safe and secure, are better able to learn and display the essentials of good citizenship. The adoption of the Uniform Dress Code can promote school safety, improve discipline, and enhance the learning environment.

The administration, faculty and staff at **Thurgood Marshall Elementary** support Clayton County Public Schools implementation of uniform dress for students according to the board policy.



Shirts: Polo or button down. **White, gold or maroon only.**

Sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets can be worn. However, students are not permitted to wear “hoodies” in the building.



Pants/Shorts (Shorts no shorter than 2 inches above the knees): **Khaki, navy or black. All pants should be worn without holes or tears.**

**\*\* No sweatpants, tights or leggings**



Dresses and Skirts: **Girls may wear dresses/skirts in khaki, navy or black.** (No shorter than 2 inches above the knees)



Sneakers/Footwear: Closed toe shoes are required for safety purposes. No crocs or slides allowed. **Sneakers are required for PE.**



**CCPS has a clear bookbag mandate. All bookbags must be clear.**

**Parents will be notified of Friday Dress Down Days in advance via Robocalls, Class Dojo and flyers. Students may wear a team/school shirt with jeans on these days.**

**\*\*Please note that on dress down days, all clothes should be school and age appropriate with no obvious holes, tears, rips, or frays.** School dress codes are a way to teach students the importance of a respectable appearance which is a lesson that can positively impact students’ self-respect and self-esteem. Adhering to the school dress code is one of the first things that a parent can do to encourage students to understand the importance of following school rules. As we set the expectation for scholars wearing uniforms daily, we ask that parents and guardians refrain from wearing bonnets, night gowns, and robes when visiting the building.
