Please LABEL all supplies with your child's name

### REQUESTED FOR GRADE LEVELS PRE-K-5

- A standard-sized backpack large enough for a lunch box and school work (no wheels)
- Computer headphones (not wireless), in a ziplock bag (**K-5 ONLY**)
- Sweatshirt to be kept at school for emergency use (will be returned)
- Art smock (an old t-shirt works best)
- Reusable water bottle



### PRE-K

- Complete change of clothes, labeled in a plastic bag (shirt, pants, underwear, and socks)
- Standard-sized bath towel or beach towel



### KINDERGARTEN

- Complete change of clothes, labeled in a plastic bag (shirt, pants, underwear, and socks)
- 1 red plastic pocket folder
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 primary ruled composition notebook (lines on bottom half of page only)
- Standard-sized bath towel or beach towel
- Pencil bag with zipper
- 1 box of washable, thin primary colored markers
- 6 large OR 12 small glue sticks
- 3 boxes of crayons (24 count)



### 1ST GRADE

- 1 plastic school supply box
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 primary ruled composition notebook (lines on bottom half of page only)
- 1 pair of kid-sized scissors
- 2 packs of 8-count washable markers
- 2 plastic folders
- 2 boxes of crayons (24 count)
- 6 large OR 12 small glue sticks
- 4 fine-line dry erase markers (black ink only)



### 2ND GRADE

- 3 folders with pockets (no prongs)
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 pair of scissors
- Plastic school supply box
- 1 box of crayons (24 count)
- 1 package of colored pencils 12-count
- 3 large OR 6 small glue sticks
- 1 box of thin washable markers 8-count



### 3RD GRADE

- 6 solid color 3 pronged plastic pocket folders: one of each color: red, black, yellow, green, blue, purple
- 4 large OR 8 small glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 box of crayons (24 count)
- 2 boxes of colored pencils 12-count
- 2 boxes of markers
- 4 one subject spiral notebooks (green, yellow, black, red and blue)
- 1 one and a half inch binder with front sleeve (Joynt, Weber ONLY)
- 1 plastic school supply box



### 4TH GRADE

- 4 large OR 8 small glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 package wide lined white filler paper
- 4 plastic folders with pockets
- 2 spiral notebooks
- 1 package of colored pencils
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 pencil pouch or pencil box



### 5TH GRADE

- 1 soft zippered pencil case
- 4 large OR 8 small glue sticks
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pack of loose-leaf paper
- 5 composition notebooks
- 5 hard plastic double pocket folders with prongs: 1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green and 1 of any color
- 1 fabric book cover size xl
- ½ inch 3 ring binder (Rozansky/Torcello, O'Shei & Washburn only)



### RISING LEARNERS K-2

- 2 water bottles (1 to be kept as an extra at school)
  - 1 art smock (or oversized t-shirt)
  - 1 emergency sweatshirt (to be left at school)
  - extra underwear and/or pull-ups (depending on your child's needs)
  - 2 complete changes of clothes
  - one 1", 3-ring binder with pockets

### LIFE SKILLS 3-5

- 1 plastic laminated 3-prong folder
  - snack (daily)
  - water bottle
  - hard pencil box
  - 1 white t-shirt (class tie dye)
  - emergency sweatshirt (to be left at school)
  - art smock/old t-shirt (labeled with your child's name)
  - complete change of clothing (labeled with your child's name)
- All field trips are funded by the district, but we will be asking families to provide money for one field trip in the string to go to a restaurant
- Please make sure your child can independently access all clothes, shoes, and gear.*

You may notice that some basic supplies are missing from your child's supply list this year. To help reduce the cost for families, OPCSD will be providing additional student supplies for all elementary students. We hope this support makes back-to-school shopping a little easier!
